Chinese developer picks London for global HQ

The Chinese company set to develop London's Royal Albert Dock has said it will establish its global headquarters in the capital.

ABP said it will set up a headquarters for 100 staff at a location in London that has yet to be announced.

The announcement comes after the firm signed a £1bn deal with London's mayor to build a business park at Royal Albert Dock near Beckton in East London.

The company's new headquarters will be capable of managing £20m of projects worldwide.
