

Huge east London schemes edge closer

Meanwhile, plans by Farrells for Chinese developer ABP and UK development manager Stanhope to transform the Royal Albert Dock into the capital's next business district have been given planning by Newham council.

The proposals will cover 437,000sq m of office space and include eight new public squares and a dockside promenade

ABP said it has received more than 60 expressions of interest from Chinese companies committing to office space on the site which covers 14ha.

Terry Farrell said: "The masterplan creates a state-of-the-art business district for financial, high-tech and knowledge driven industries."
