



# Brookfield Multiplex confirmed for principal subcontractor role on Royal Albert Dock

Brookfield Multiplex will work with Chinese firm Citic Construction to build the first phase of the £1.7bn Royal Albert Dock scheme, its developer has confirmed.

ABP said Brookfield Multiplex has been appointed as principal subcontractor, with Citic acting as the main contractor.

*Construction News* revealed last October that ABP had selected Citic to build its project, with [three major UK firms lined up to take on the principal subcontractor role.](#)

The £200m first phase includes the construction of around 700,000 sq ft of office and retail space.

Careys is carrying out the £2m enabling works, which will take about 14 weeks to complete before full construction can begin.

ABP chairman Xu Weiping said: “The bilateral exchanges between China and the UK have never been stronger and the progress of the project demonstrates ABP’s commitment to creating London’s next business district at Royal Albert Dock and creating better life and more jobs to the area by promoting the trade between UK and Asia.”

GLA deputy mayor for housing James Murray said: “Despite the recent decision to leave the European Union, this reminds us that London is open and is the best place in the world to do business.”
