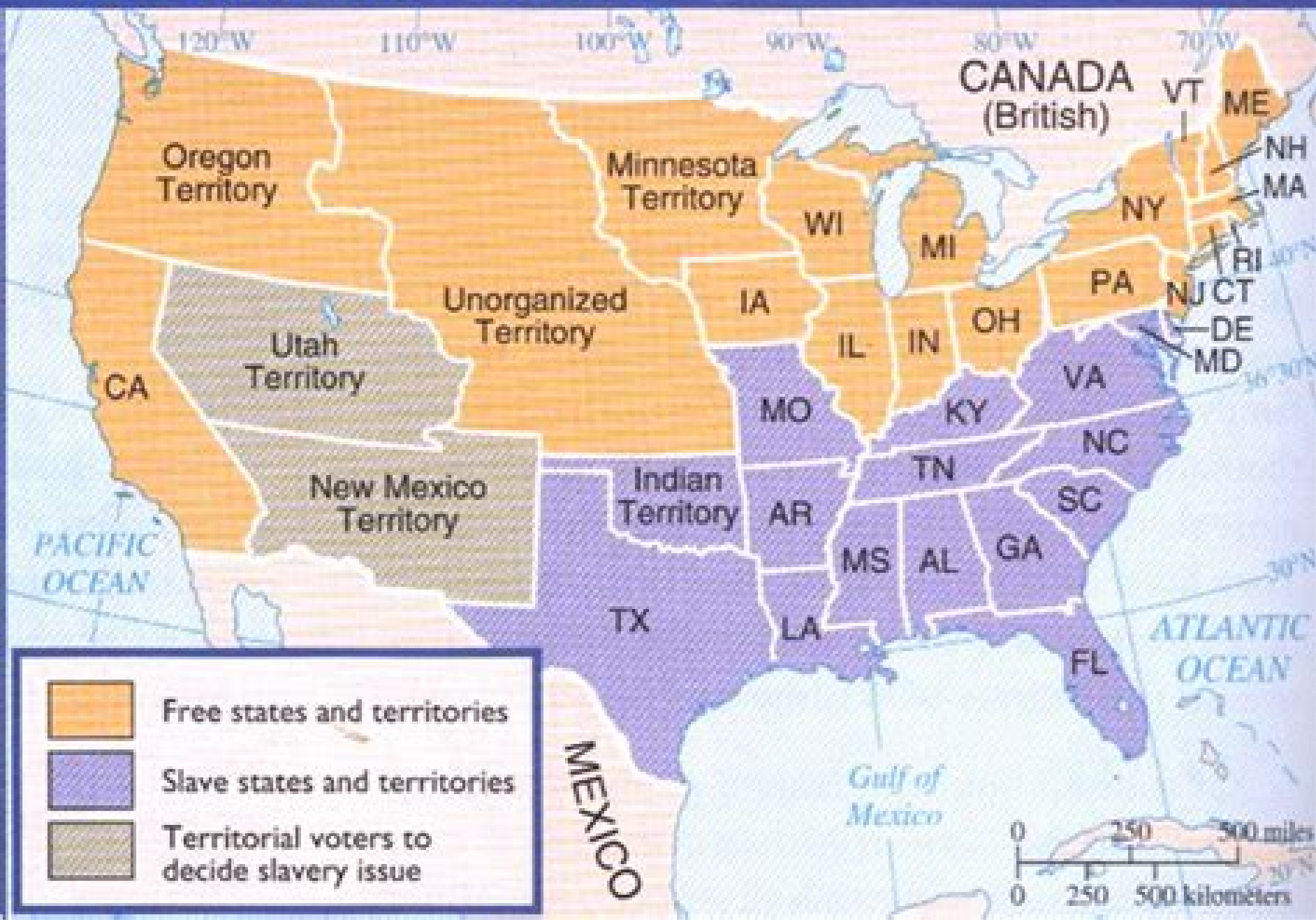

Between Harvard and America: The Educational Leadership of Charles W.
