The Man Who Closed the Asylums John Foot, 2023-08-01 When the wind of the 1960s blew through the world of psychiatry In 1961 when Franco Basaglia arrived outside the grim walls of the Gorizia asylum on the Italian border with Yugoslavia it was a place of horror a Bedlam for the mentally sick and excluded redolent of Basaglia's own wartime experience inside a fascist gaol Patients were frequently restrained for long periods and therapy was largely a matter of electric and insulin shocks The corridors stank and for many of the interned the doors were locked for life This was a concentration camp not a hospital Basaglia the new Director was expected to practise all the skills of oppression in which he had been schooled but he would have none of this The place had to be closed down by opening it up from the inside bringing freedom and democracy to the patients the nurses and the psychiatrists working in that total institution Inspired by the writings of authors such as Primo Levi R D Laing Erving Goffman Michel Foucault and Frantz Fanon and the practices of experimental therapeutic communities in the UK Basaglia's seminal work as a psychiatrist and campaigner in Gorizia Parma and Trieste fed into and substantially contributed to the national and international movement of 1968 In 1978 a law was passed the Basaglia law which sanctioned the closure of the entire Italian asylum system The first comprehensive study of this revolutionary approach to mental health care *The Man Who Closed the Asylums* is a gripping account of one of the most influential movements in twentieth century psychiatry which helped to transform the way we see mental illness Basaglia's work saved countless people from a miserable existence and his legacy persists as an object lesson in the struggle against the brutality and ignorance that the establishment peddles to the public as common sense *West Germany and the Global Sixties* Timothy Scott Brown, 2013-10-10 The anti authoritarian revolt of the 1960s and 1970s was a watershed in the history of the Federal Republic of Germany The rebellion of the so called 68ers against cultural conformity and the ideological imperatives of the Cold War against the American war in Vietnam and in favor of a more open accounting for the crimes of the Nazi era helped to inspire a dialogue on democratization with profound effects on German society Timothy Scott Brown examines the unique synthesis of globalizing influences on West Germany to reveal how the presence of Third World students imported pop culture from America and England and the influence of new political doctrines worldwide all helped to precipitate the revolt The book explains how the events in West Germany grew out of a new interplay of radical politics and popular culture even as they drew on principles of direct democracy self organization and self determination all still highly relevant in the present day **Socialists and International Actions for Peace 1914-1923** Masao Nishikawa, 2010-10-21 The analyses and accounts of the history of the Second International often go up to 1914 the year its anti war efforts were to prove futile All actions of the socialists during World War I were discussed in the context of the pathway to the Third International The author aims to present a somewhat different picture from existing views by examining the thoughts and actions of socialists in the years 1914 1923 beyond the framework of whether they supported or opposed the Third
