1st World War Poetry:

Poetry of the First World War Tim Kendall, 2013-10-10 The First World War produced an extraordinary flowering of poetic talent poets whose words commemorate the conflict more personally and as enduringly as monuments in stone Lines such as What passing bells for these who die as cattle and They shall grow not old as we that are left grow old have come to express the feelings of a nation about the horrors and aftermath of war This new anthology provides a definitive record of the achievements of the Great War poets As well as offering generous selections from the celebrated soldier poets including Wilfred Owen Siegfried Sassoon Rupert Brooke and Ivor Gurney it also incorporates less well known writing by civilian and women poets Music hall and trench songs provide a further lyrical perspective on the War A general introduction charts the history of the war poets reception and challenges prevailing myths about the war poets progress from idealism to bitterness The work of each poet is prefaced with a biographical account that sets the poems in their historical context Although the War has now passed out of living memory its haunting of our language and culture has not been exorcised Its poetry survives because it continues to speak to and about us *The Nation's Cause* Elizabeth A. Marsland, 2012-11-12 As we approach the centenary of the outbreak of the First World War this timely reissue first published in 1991 evaluates the function of poetry in wartime Europe arguing that war poetry must be understood as a social as well as a literary phenomenon As well as locating the work of well known French English and German war poets in a European context Elizabeth Marsland discusses lesser known poetry of the war years including poems by women and the neglected tradition of civilian protest through poetry Identifying shared characteristics as well as the unique features of each nation's poetry *The Nation's Cause* affords new insight into the relationship between nationalism and the social attitudes that determined the conduct of war

Women's Poetry of the First World War Nosheen Khan, 1988-01-01 *The Penguin Book of First World War Poetry* Jon Silkin, 1979 Includes some poems translated from French German and Italian *The Wordsworth Book of First World War Poetry* Marcus Clapham, 1995 This anthology serves as an introduction to the poetry of World War I and the inclusion of a number rarely anthologized poets many from the ranks as well as anonymous poems and songs attempts to bring a quality of freshness to the selection **In Flanders Fields** Brian Busby, 2005-10-05 Few people alive today had direct experience of the First World War and yet it seems embedded in the collective consciousness of the combatant nations as a warning to future generations of the futility of military conflict Our awareness of the terror loneliness and desperate hope endured by the men who fought this war we owe to the quality of the art that came out of it not least the poetry Despite the passage of time its ability to move and inspire us remains undimmed as this superb new compilation richly demonstrates Selected from the work of soldiers killed in action starting with Rupert Brooke in 1915 and ending with the tragic loss of Wilfred Owen seven days before the Armistice the poems capture a broad range of emotions contemplations and states of mind ranging from anthems about the brutality of war to wistful evocations of home and loved ones left behind This collection showcases

some of the best poetry to emerge from the conflict and stands as a worthy memorial to the collective talent and sacrifice of those who gave their lives

The German Poets of the First World War Patrick Bridgwater, 2020-01-31 Originally published in 1985 this book provides a full survey of the best and most significant work of German writers to the First World War Including in both German and English the texts of all the main poems discussed this book contains many not readily available elsewhere Authors discussed include Trakl Rilke and George as well as less familiar names The book not only corrects the distorted view of the subject perpetuated by most histories of German literature but will also help to English First World War poetry into perspective

First World War Poets Alan Judd, David Crane, 1997 Part of the Character Sketches series this title looks at World War I poets The series features compact guides devoted to literary artistic and historic personalities circles and themes They contain portraits in a variety of media all selected from the National Portrait Gallery's diverse collection

The First World War in Irish Poetry Jim Haughey, 2002-04 This first book length study of Irish poetry about the First World War examines the extent to which the war has been preserved and appropriated in Irish memory While the early chapters explore the various historical myths about Ireland's role in the war and review the war verse written by Irish soldier poets the attention later shifts to Irish poets on the various home fronts who express a wide range of attitudes toward the war

The War Poems Siegfried Sassoon, 2016-09-18 Siegfried Loraine Sassoon CBE MC 8 September 1886 1 September 1967 was an English poet writer and soldier Decorated for bravery on the Western Front he became one of the leading poets of the First World War His poetry both described the horrors of the trenches and satirised the patriotic pretensions of those who in Sassoon's view were responsible for a jingoism fuelled war Sassoon became a focal point for dissent within the armed forces when he made a lone protest against the continuation of the war in his Soldier's Declaration of 1917 culminating in his admission to a military psychiatric hospital Excerpt from Wikipedia
