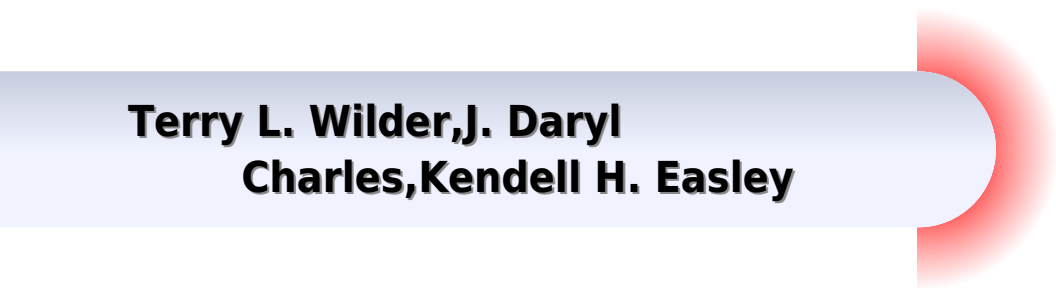

But all the while, these documents express the constancy and commitment of those who found salvation and the renewal of life in the one Lord Jesus Christ.
