Arshile Gorky, 1904-1948 Diane Waldman, Arshile Gorky, 1981 Catalogue of an exhibition held at the Solomon R Guggenheim Museum Rethinking Arshile Gorky, A reexamination of the art of Arshile Gorky 1904-1948 and an exploration of his role in the development of modern abstraction in America **Arshile Gorky** Arshile Gorky, Gerardo Delgado, Fundació Caixa de Pensions, 1990 Born on the shores of Armenia's Lake Van Arshile Gorky immigrated to the United States in 1920 and went on to become one of the greatest American painters of the twentieth century Gorky was both a forefather to and a seminal figure in the Abstract Expressionist movement years before Pollock and Motherwell he found ways to extend Surrealist dream imagery into a uniquely American abstraction simply by pursuing Surrealism's insistence on the authenticity of interior experience freely transcribed on canvas also the logic of much New York Abstract Expressionism For Gorky this was no easy endeavor critic Meyer Schapiro called him a fervent scrutinizer of paintings an ability corroborated by his close friend Willem de Kooning whose own painting owes much to Gorky for some mysterious reason he knew lots more about painting and art He had an extraordinary gift for hitting the nail on the head Although Gorky's life was cut short by his suicide in 1948 the tremendously influential legacy that he left behind has secured his reputation as the last of the great Surrealist painters and one of the first Abstract Expressionists Here reproductions of key works are accompanied by Gorky's own writings and a collection of interviews Modernism for the Masses Jody Patterson, 2020-11-17 A mural renaissance swept the United States in the 1930s propelled by the New Deal Federal Art Project and the popularity of Mexican muralism Perhaps nowhere more than in New York City murals became a crucial site for the development of abstract painting Artists such as Stuart Davis Arshile Gorky Willem de Kooning and Lee Krasner created ambitious works for the Williamsburg Housing Project Floyd Bennett Field Airport and the 1939 World's Fair Modernism for the Masses examines the public murals realized and unrealized of these and other abstract painters and the aesthetic controversy political influence and ideological warfare that surrounded them Jody Patterson transforms standard narratives of modernism by reasserting the significance of the 1930s and explores the reasons for the omission of the mural's history from chronicles of American art Beautifully illustrated with the artists' murals and little known archival photographs this book recovers the radical idea that modernist art was a vital part of everyday life *Arshile Gorky* Robert Saltonstall Mattison, Arshile Gorky, 2009 Arshile Gorky emigrated from Armenia to the United States in 1920 where he established himself as one of the greatest painters of that period Although his life was cut short by his suicide in 1948 the body of work he left behind secured his reputation as one of the greatest surrealist painters This book tells his story **Abstract Expressionism** Metropolitan Museum of Art (New York, N.Y.), Lisa Mintz Messinger, 1992 Abstract Expressionist works on paper from the permanent collection of The Metropolitan Museum of Art are presented in this volume which documents the wealth of the Museum's holdings in that area Many of them are published here for the first time and several are recent additions to the collection All

are illustrated in full page color reproductions that show the nuances of each work in great detail The Abstract Expressionists are best known for their paintings and sculptures and virtually all of the many publications about these artists concentrate on those large scale works This unique catalogue deals exclusively with their smaller more intimate works on paper providing many new insights about the routes that led to the Abstract Expressionists innovative artistic accomplishments The nineteen artists included are William Baziotas James Brooks Elaine de Kooning Willem de Kooning Arshile Gorky Adolph Gottlieb Philip Guston Gerome Kamrowski Franz Kline Robert Motherwell Barnett Newman Jackson Pollock Richard Pousette Dart Theodore Roszak Mark Rothko Anne Ryan David Smith Theodoros Stamos and Mark Tobey Each of them is discussed in a separate essay which encompasses information about the artist s background and development commentary about the importance of drawing in his or her oeuvre and an analysis of each work in the selection Also included in the essays is technical information about a number of the individual works that enhances understanding of the variety and originality of these artists media and techniques

Arshile Gorky Dore Ashton, Arshile Gorky, Michael Auping, Matthew Spender, 1995 Michael Auping s valuable text provides an introduction to the life and art of Arshile Gorky as well as an insightful consideration of the grand psychological landscape The Liver is the Cock s Comb 1944 a work pivotal to the development of Gorky s style Dore Ashton writes a lucid account of this artist who tends to resist classification contributing an art historical overview of Gorky s appreciation of such modern innovators of abstraction and Surrealism as Miro and Kandinsky Matthew Spender provides biographical details of Gorky s early years while a selection of Gorky s personal letters further sheds an intimate light on the artist and his achievements

Graphic Modernism Art Institute of Chicago, 2003 This exhibition catalog highlights a recent gift of works on paper to the Art Institute of Chicago from the Gecht family longtime Chicago collectors The catalog comprises 135 drawings prints and sculptures from the collection all of which embody a broad definition of Modernism The book spans two centuries and contains artists such as Cezanne and Van Gogh as well as Mark Rothko and Philip Guston Toulouse Lautrec Matisse and Picasso form the backbone of the collection with nearly 30 works of art apiece Suzanne Folds McCullagh curator of prints drawings Art Inst of Chicago provides a short introductory essay that tracks the evolution of the collection Authored by a bevy of contributors the well written entries maintain a consistent tone and quality and strike a good balance between biographical information and interpretations of the work of art itself While the Gecht collection is certainly quite a boon for the institute it is not comprehensive enough in itself to make the catalog essential for all art libraries It does however belong on library shelves with strong modern art and graphics collections Kraig A Binkowski Delaware Art Museum Wilmington 135 colour illustrations
