

Frank, 2022-02-02 Griot Potters of the Folona reconstructs the past of a particular group of West African women potters using evidence found in their artistry and techniques The potters of the Folona region of southeastern Mali serve a diverse clientele and firing thousands of pots weekly during the height of the dry season Although they identify themselves as Mande the unique styles and types of
