Italy's Renaissance in Buildings and Gardens Frederick Kiefer, 2024-10-08 Palaces villas and churches These were the highlights of my first visit to Italy I took a lot of photos and looked forward to sharing them with friends and family Back home though I found that I didn't recall much about the places that impressed me Although I had the benefit of a half day guide in Rome Florence and Venice I sometimes had difficulty hearing what was said on crowded streets and busy interiors The guides were capable but had only enough time to mention a few major features As a rule they skimmed on actually describing buildings that intrigued me And so they were not especially helpful in providing the insights I wanted Upon my return I found myself wondering Where did the architects actually find their ideas What did they want to accomplish And what do their choices tell us about their time My sojourn in Italy would have been more satisfying if I had come away with a fuller account of what I had seen What I most needed was context This book supplies that context Contemplation of antiquity and the exchange of views among architects released a surge of intellectual energy not seen for a millennium a development that would never have happened so quickly were it not for Johannes Gutenberg's invention of printing with movable type This development in turn led to architects heightened self awareness of their collective enterprise They read what their fellow architects wrote and thereby gained in sophistication They were no longer merely masons They became architects in the modern sense They took pride in their achievements and shared a conviction that the visual culture they created was far superior to that of the previous thousand years Their embrace of classical civilisation had a visceral urgency Rome after all was a culture with a storied past peopled by larger than life figures To learn what the ancients had created in word or stone could supply a shortcut to wisdom And emulating the Romans would provide new models of aesthetic excellence This endeavour became known as the Renaissance or rebirth The Reformation however changed everything Martin Luther

brought to issue a quandary How exactly was Christianity to be reconciled with the pagan past if at all Could one source of inspiration be sustained without compromising the other Religious reform questioned the aesthetic achievements of the previous hundred years The story of Renaissance architecture represents the effort to find an accommodation **The Rome of Peter and Paul** Brian Schmisek, 2017-10-12 This handbook is a short guide for those who are interested in Roman sites that have something to do with the New Testament and in particular with Peter and Paul For more than ten years Dr Schmisek has led graduate ministry programs in the Eternal City This book is informed by the questions insights and comments from students over those years While not addressing each and every claimed New Testament artifact in the city of Rome the handbook focuses on the more significant churches and locales that have a connection to Petrine and Pauline legends places such as St Peter's at the Vatican and St Paul's outside the Walls are included but also St Peter's at Montorio and Tre Fontane There are two primary parts to this book the first is a brief survey of what is known and not known regarding Peter and Paul's time in Rome The various sources of Pauline and Petrine legends are included in this survey as those legends are key to interpreting many sites and their significance The second part of the book is more akin to a tour book laid out in four subsections generally corresponding to geographical areas of the city This brief handbook will be a valuable guide to those who seek a greater understanding of the historical and legendary background to Petrine and Pauline sites in Rome **Time Matter(s): Invention and Re-Imagination in Built Conservation** Federica Goffi, 2016-02-24 Even though the idea of altering an existing building is presently a well established practice within the context of adaptive reuse when the building in question is a mnemonic building of recognized heritage value alterations are viewed with suspicion even when change is a recognized necessity This book fills in a blind spot in current architectural theory and practice looking into a notion of conservation as a form of invention and imagination offering the reader a counter viewpoint to a predominant western understanding that preservation should be a still shot from the past Through a micro historical study of a Renaissance concept of restoration a theoretical framework to question the issue of conservation as a creative endeavor arises It focuses on Tiberio Alfarano's 1571 ichnography of St Peter's Basilica in the Vatican into which a complex body of religious political architectural and cultural elements is woven By merging past and present temple's plans he created a track drawing questioning the design pursued after Michelangelo's death 1564 opening the gaze towards other possible future imaginings This book uncovers how the drawing was acted on by Carlo Maderno 1556 1629 who literally used it as physical substratum to for new design proposals completing the renewal of the temple in 1626 Proposing a hybrid architectural conservation approach this study shows how these two practices can be merged in contemporary renovation By creating hybrid drawings the retrospective and prospective gaze of built conservation forms a continuous and contiguous reality where a pre-existent condition engages with future design rejoining multiple temporalities within continuity of identity This study might provide a paradigmatic and timely model to retune contemporary architectural sensibility when dealing with
