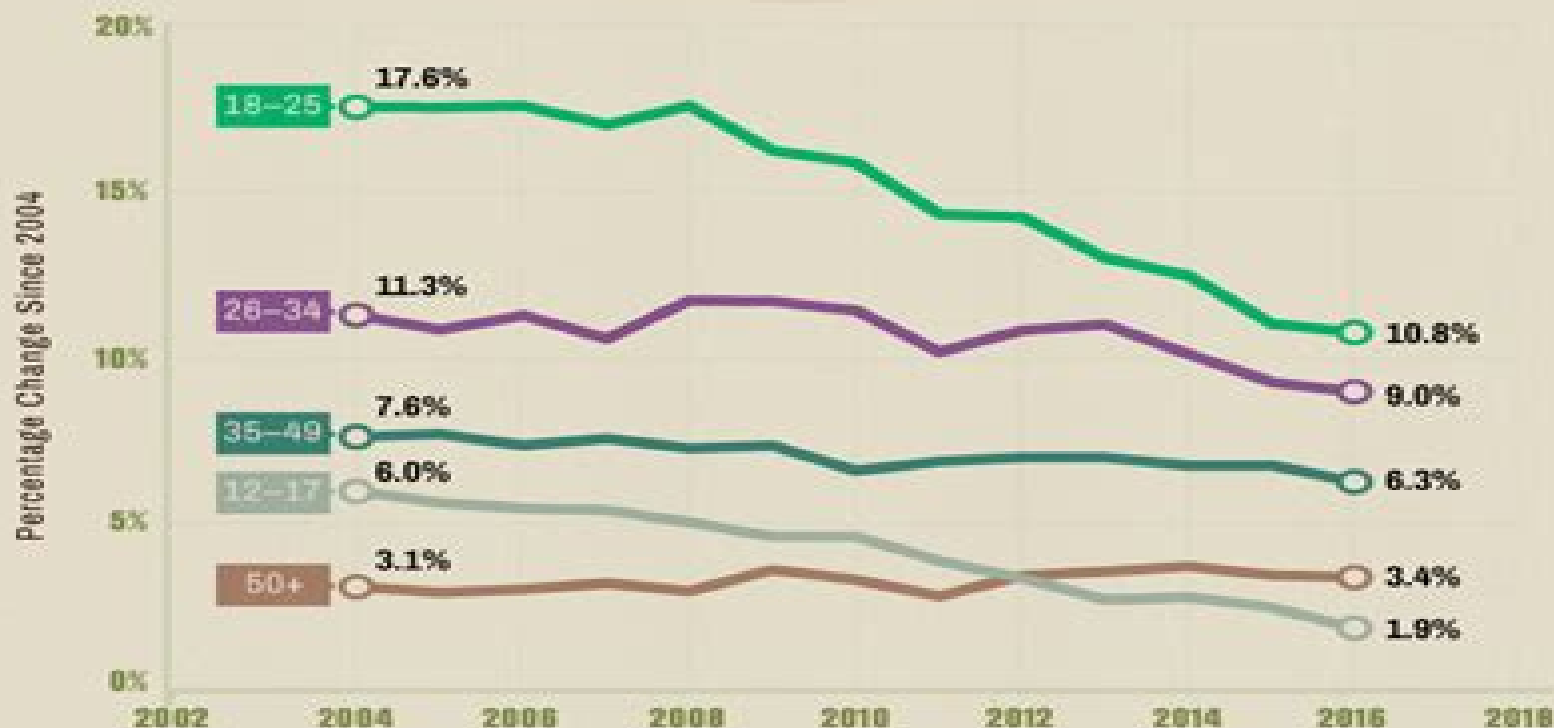

Curto, 2003-12-01 Long recognized as having played many important roles in the slave export trade of western Africa foreign alcohol and its various functions within this context have nevertheless escaped systematic analysis This volume focuses on the topic at Luanda and its Hinterland where the connections between foreign alcohol and the slave export trade reached their zenith Here following the mid 1500s an extremely close relationship developed between imported intoxicants and slaves exported by the thousands in any given year into the Atlantic World first fortified Portuguese wine and following 1650 Brazilian rum emerged as crucial trade goods for the acquisition of slaves But the significance of Luso Brazilian intoxicants goes far beyond this singular fact they also served a number of other functions some of which were directly tied to slave trading and others indirectly underpinned the business The volume addresses the problem of alcohol in African history historicizes indigenous alcoholic beverages in West Central

Africa at the time of contact analyzes the introduction and increasing use of foreign intoxicants for the acquisition of exportable slaves ponders the profits that such transactions generated within the Atlantic world reconstructs the other uses of imported alcohol in directly and indirectly underpinning the export slave trade of Luanda and assesses the impact of foreign alcohol upon West Central African consumers

Mancall, 2018-07-05 An important work of scholarship with powerful concise and objective insights into the complicated history of alcohol use among Native American peoples Impeccably researched cogently argued and clearly written Peter Mancall's book is both an eye opener for the lay reader and an invaluable resource for the expert Michael Dorris author of *The Broken Cord* A Family's Ongoing Struggle with Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Alcohol abuse has killed and impoverished American Indians since the seventeenth century when European settlers began trading rum for furs In the first book to probe the origins of this ongoing social crisis Peter C Mancall explores the liquor trade's devastating impact on the Indian communities of colonial America Mancall recounts how English settlers quickly found a market for alcohol among the Indians and traffic in rum became a prominent source of revenue for the British Empire In spite of the colonists growing awareness that some Indians abused alcohol and that drinking threatened the stability of countless Indian villages already decimated by European diseases they expanded the liquor trade into virtually every Indian community from the Atlantic to the Mississippi In response Indians created one of the most important temperance

movements in American history a movement that was nevertheless unable to halt the lucrative commerce The author follows the trail of rum from the West Indian producers to the colonial distributors and on to the Indian consumers in the eastern woodlands To discover why Indians participated in the trade and why they experienced such a powerful desire for alcohol he addresses current medical views on alcoholism and reexamines the colonial era as a time when Indians were forming new strategies for survival in a world that had been radically changed Finally Mancall compares Indian drinking in New France and New Spain with that in the British colonies Forever shattering the stereotype of the drunken Indian Mancall offers a powerful indictment of English participation in the liquor trade and a new awareness of the trade's tragic cost for the American Indians

**The Bahamas in American History** Keith Tinker, 2011-11-30 THIS BOOK EXPLORES the many complex historical connections between the United States of America and the Commonwealth of The Bahamas Beginning with an overview of shared early Spanish colonization the book is the first attempt to provide a comprehensive study of the impact of the sequential development of the United States on events in the emerging Bahamas placing the heretofore marginalized history of the island nation firmly into the orbit of Atlantic historiographical literature Among other things the book sheds light on the role played by the islands in a series of significant events in the U S history These include the American Revolution in which four of the initial official military actions of the fledgling U S Navy comprised repeated invasions of British controlled Nassau capital of the Bahamas the American Civil War during which Nassau became one of the main bases for supply of vital goods and ammunition to the Confederacy the intrigues of the Volstead Act which legislated prohibition but also caused the temporary transformation of Bahama Islands into major transshipment centers for the smuggling of alcoholic beverages to a multitude of prohibition defiant and thirsty Americans and the significant role played by Bahamian migrants in the creation of the city of Miami and other areas of south Florida The author draws on a wealth of tapped and untapped primary sources and presents a new perspective on the Bahamian experience that helped to define the self-proclaimed American credo of Manifest Destiny
