Dryden's Criticism Robert D. Hume, 1970 The Just and the Lively Michael Werth Gelber, 2002 Recognition is often considered a means to de escalate conflicts and promote peaceful social interactions This volume explores the forms that social recognition and its withholding may take in asymmetric armed conflicts examining the risks and opportunities that arise when local state and transnational actors recognise misrecognise or deny recognition of armed non state actors By studying key asymmetric conflicts through the prism of recognition it offers an innovative perspective on the interactions between armed non state actors and state actors In what contexts does granting recognition to armed non state actors foster conflict transformation What happens when governments withhold recognition or label armed non state actors in ways they perceive as misrecognition The authors examine the ambivalence of recognition processes in violent conflicts and their sometimes unintended consequences The volume shows that while non recognition prevents conflict transformation the recognition of armed non state actors may produce counterproductive precedents and new modes of exclusion in intra state and transnational politics **Neo-Classical Dramatic Criticism 1560-1770** Thora Burnley Jones, Bernard De Bear Nicol, 1976-02-19 This book which was originally published in 1976 is an interpretation of the thought of the major neo classical dramatic critics in Italy France and England during the period 1560 1770 Commentary is based in every case on a careful reading of original texts by for instance Scaliger Castelvetro Corneille D Aubignac Dryden Johnson Diderot Mercier which have been translated by the authors where necessary and are liberally quoted and leads to the conclusion that neo classicism found its natural fulfilment in nineteenth century naturalism Far from being academic artificial doctrinaire or rigid pejorative terms usually applied to them the neo classical critics were asking fundamental questions about the nature of drama The book attempts to place a selection of early European dramatic criticism in a fresh context It brings together a good deal of information not available elsewhere and presents it in a form which non specialist readers will find easy to assimilate and which specialists will find stimulating as a sophisticated critical interpretation of neo classicism **The Emergence of Dramatic Criticism in England** P. James Garrison, 2023-04-28 *Dryden and the Tradition of Panegyric* explores the intriguing relationship between two distinct literary forms: the epic and panegyric. The study begins with a question inspired by a remark made by John Dryden in his *Account of Annus Mirabilis*, where he suggests that the same images serve equally for the epic poesy and for the historic and panegyric. This curious observation led the author to investigate the tradition of panegyric in the seventeenth century, which had been largely overlooked. By examining works that claimed to belong to this genre, the study uncovers a literary tradition that warrants serious consideration, particularly for those interested in Dryden's poetry. The book recovers this tradition in chapters 2 and 3 and explores its influence on Dryden's work in chapters 4 and 5. The book also offers translations of Latin panegyrics and critical commentary on them, with most translations prepared by Salle Ann Schlueter. This work sheds new light on Dryden's connection to the tradition of panegyric and offers readers a deeper understanding of its role in his poetry and its broader significance in literary history.
