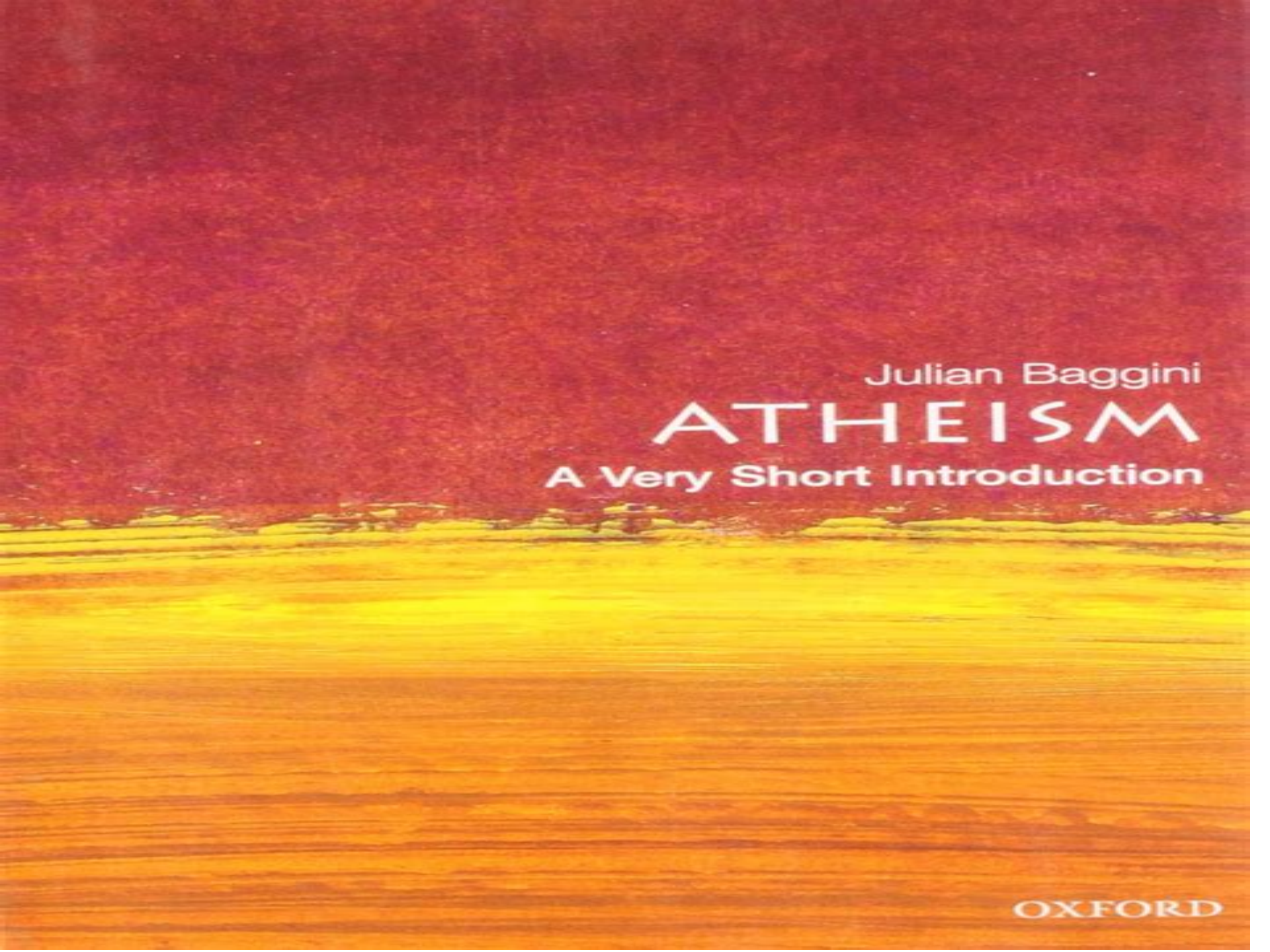

theism by adding various auxiliary hypotheses to it whether in the form of Christian doctrines or sceptical claims or speculations about God's reasons for allowing suffering These attempts are shown to be of no help to the core theist Finally in a concluding chapter the justificatory gap between the belief that core atheism is very probably true and the belief that it is true is bridged by arguing that the high probability of core atheism is stable
