#### Genomic instability

DNA damage that mutates cells and can potentially cause cancer and other harmful cell behaviors.



#### **Telomere Attrition**

The protective caps on our chromosomes erode, which leads to loss of tissue regeneration.



#### **Epigenetic Alterations**

Changes to gene expression that make cells old and more dysfunctional.



#### Loss of Proteostasis

Loss of efficient protein creation and the accumulation of cellular waste.



#### Deregulated Nutrient Sensing

Failure of appropriate nutrient responses leads to problems with cell growth, energy production, and other cellular functions.



#### Mitochondrial Dysfunction

Free radicals and oxidative stress damage to the mitochondria lead to mitochondrial mutations and failure of energy production.



#### Cellular Senescence

Worm out, damaged cells accumulate, which leads to chronic inflammation and loss of tissue regeneration.



#### Stem Cell Exhaustion

Damaged tissues fail to regenerate as stem cells lose their ability to generate healthy replacement cells.



#### Altered Intercellular Communication

Altered cell-to-cell communication leads to chronic inflammation and dysfunctional cell behavior.
