Every time she found a nice place to reside in the city she was called back to Shooters Hill for the pea harvest by an obligation she undertook with her brother Bert before leaving the Hill She maintains her connection with home In between pea harvests she was able to travel and finds work in many different and interesting environment Her improved wardrobe and experience was leading her into a better and better lifestyle and finally she marries at the age of 25 and begins her married life with John Patrick Duggan Together they establish a large and famous family of publicans graziers and transport carriers Her stories are told in an amusing self deprecating voice as if she was writing to a friend Her descriptions are voiced in such a way as to make the reader believe they were actually there themselves and that makes for easy reading Remember Them Peter Isaacson, 2012 My Journey As I Remember Darrell D.
