Bertolt Brecht's Dramatic Theory John J. White,2004 In concert with his work as a politically charged playwright and dramaturge Bertolt Brecht concerned himself extensively with the theory of drama He was convinced that the Aristotelian ideal of audience catharsis through identification with a hero and the resultant experience of terror and pity worked against his goal of bettering society He did not want his audiences to feel but to think and his main theoretical thrusts *Verfremdungseffekte* de familiarization effects and epic theater among others were conceived in pursuit of this goal This is the first detailed study in English of Brecht's writings on the theater to take account of works first made available in the
