A 1992 study (McKee & Gernsma) found that 65 percent of all free writing time in second-, fourth-, and sixth-grade classrooms was spent on paper and pencil activities. A more recent study (McCormack, Cohen & Henderson, 2013) noted that kindergarten children are now spending 32 percent of their free writing time on paper and pencil activities.

The addition of handwriting components to many state tests assessments and of a handwriting essay to the College Board SAT in 2015 further emphasize the importance of handwriting. Furthermore, good handwriting is important long after graduation in Script and Scribble (2019). Flannery writes in
