The Spanish Baroque and Latin American Literary Modernity Crystal Anne Chemris, 2021 This book aims to develop a broader view of the trajectory of Hispanic modernity tracing a motif of recurring impasse first seen in peninsular Baroque texts and continuing into Latin American colonial and modern literature Inspired by Walter Benjamin's notion of constellation this book draws on theories of Latin American modernity to investigate the Spanish literary Baroque and its repetitions as a historical cultural predicament in Latin American colonial and modern texts Inca Garcilaso Borges Carpentier Rulfo Daro and a range of Latin American Post Symbolist poets Agustini Pizarnik Sosa Lienlaf and Huinao are juxtaposed with the Lazarillo the Quijote Fuenteovejuna and Góngora's Soledades to produce original readings on topics of violence rape frustrated pilgrimage and the truncated ambitions of colonized peoples and confessional minorities In turn Benjamin is juxtaposed with Mallarmé to recast the aesthetic dynamics of modernity in political terms in order to understand the Baroque within a more broadly historicized concept of the avant garde Generous in scope this book addresses the community of Spanish and Latin American criticism as well as emerging and pressing theoretical concerns within the field of comparative literature

Minos and the Moderns Theodore Ziolkowski, 2008-07-17 Minos and the Moderns considers three mythological complexes that enjoyed a unique surge of interest in early twentieth century European art and literature Europa and the bull the minotaur and the labyrinth and Daedalus and Icarus All three are situated on the island of Crete and are linked by the figure of King Minos Drawing examples from fiction poetry drama painting sculpture opera and ballet Minos and the Moderns is the first book of its kind to treat the role of the Cretan myths in the modern imagination Beginning with the resurgence of Crete in the modern consciousness in 1900 following the excavations of Sir Arthur Evans Theodore Ziolkowski shows how the tale of Europa in poetry drama and art but also in cartoons advertising and currency was initially seized upon as a story of sexual awakening then as a vehicle for social and political satire and finally as a symbol of European unity In contrast the minotaur provided artists ranging from Picasso to Dürer with an image of the artist's sense of alienation while the labyrinth suggested to many writers the threatening sociopolitical world of the twentieth century Ziolkowski also

considers the roles of such modern figures as Marx Nietzsche and Freud of travelers to Greece and Crete from Isadora Duncan to Henry Miller and of the theorists and writers including T S Eliot and Thomas Mann who hailed the use of myth in modern literature Minos and the Moderns concludes with a summary of the manners in which the economic aesthetic psychological and anthropological revisions enabled precisely these myths to be taken up as a mirror of modern consciousness The book will appeal to all readers interested in the classical tradition and its continuing relevance and especially to scholars of Classics and modern literatures Writing and the Origins of Greek Literature Barry B.

This book aims to reconceptualise the Graeco-Roman military phenomenon of the war cry; the term itself is inadequate for defining an ancient military practice that has been misrepresented in modern media and understudied by contemporary scholars. Gersbach introduces the term and paradigm, battle expression, to replace war cry, which acknowledges the variety of undertakings, visual and sonic, that military forces from the Graeco-Roman world presented on the battlefield before, during, or after battle. The battle expression was sophisticated in nature; it could include significant cultural song or dance that required high levels of rehearsal and execution. Conversely, battle expression types demonstrated spontaneous wit and humour on the part of a military force that aimed to capitalise on the experiences of a battle. These performances served a variety of purposes outside of instilling group cohesion among the participants and to intimidate the onlooking enemy. This book associates the psychological dimension of warfare, religious identity, and military strategy supported by the High Command to this practice.
