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The first global classical tradition

In 1852, after crossing the Sahara Desert, the German traveler Heinrich Barth reached Massenya, the capital of the Sultanate of Bagirmi in what is now Chad.¹ Barth was not the first western European to explore the inner regions of Africa, but he was the first to do so with scholarly interests in the cultures that he visited. One of the things that struck Barth in this place so far away from Europe was that he encountered someone who was steeped in classical Greco-Roman learning there. He would later describe this encounter in his *Travels and Discoveries in North and Central Africa* as follows:

I could scarcely have expected to find in this out-of-the-way place a man not only versed in all the branches of Arabic literature, but who had even read (nay, possessed a manuscript of) those portions of Aristotle and Plato which had been translated into, or rather Mohammedanized in Arabic, and who possessed the most intimate knowledge of the countries which he had visited.²
