Understanding Inequality in China Xiaogang Wu, Jia Miao, 2024-11-11 This edited volume provides an overview of inequality and stratification in contemporary China A rare and timely resource it presents key research on the topic published in Chinese Sociological Review from 2011 to 2023 using one or multiple waves of Chinese General Social Survey CGSS data reflecting the advancement of the field over
