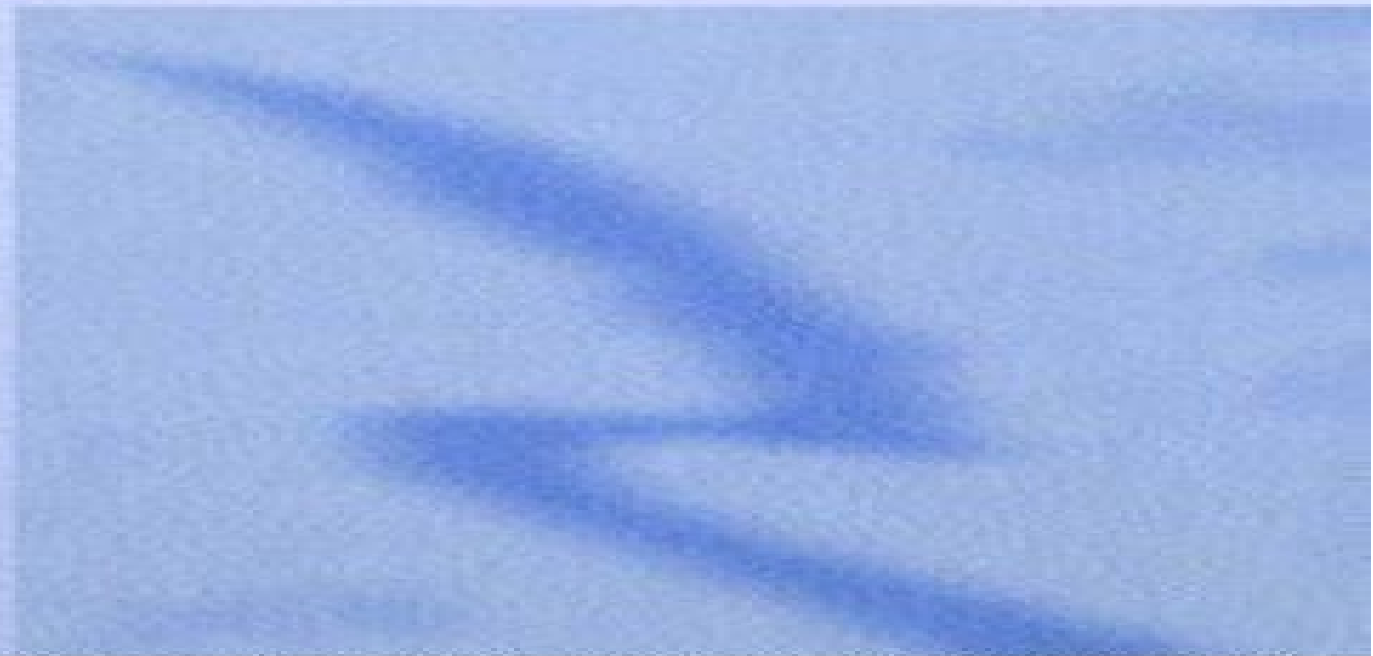

Above all, it offers new ways of thinking about class theory and the relationships between classes in late modern society.
