Pater but it also includes close analysis of other prose writers as well as poets and novelists ranging from William Blake to Robert Browning George Eliot to Henry James Significant developments addressed include the vogue for the representation of Old Masters in the first half of the century ongoing innovations in the creation and diffusion of reproductions and the emergence of the field of art history itself At the heart of each of these the book identifies a material pressure shaping concepts texts and works of art

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
