Three hundred games were then selected that appeared to have features consistent with the criteria. The 300 games were evaluated with scores, points given for each category of criteria. The games were then ranked one to 100 by the score they received. No attempt was made to balance the selection according to period, nationality of players, or opening. Also included is a chapter on the most overrated games of the twentieth century and one on games that would have made the list if. 

