heir of Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek was born in 1910 when Chinese women nearly all illiterate hobbled about on bound feet and men wore pigtails as symbols of subservience to the Manchu Dynasty In his youth Ching-kuo was a Communist and a Trotskyite and he lived twelve years in Russia He died in 1988 as the leader of Taiwan a Chinese society with a flourishing consumer economy and a budding but already wild woolly and open democracy He was an actor in many of the events of the last century that shaped the history of China's struggles and achievements in the modern era the surge of nationalism among Chinese youth the grand appeal of Marxism-Leninism the terrible battle against fascist Japan and the long destructive civil war between the Nationalists and the Communists In 1949 he fled to Taiwan with his father and two million Nationalists He led the brutal suppression of dissent on the island and was a major player in the cold sometimes hot war between Communist China and America By reacting to changing economic social and political dynamics on Taiwan Sino-American rapprochement Deng Xiaoping's sweeping reforms on the mainland and other international events he led Taiwan on a zigzag but ultimately successful transition from dictatorship to democracy Jay Taylor underscores the interaction of political developments on the mainland and in Taiwan and concludes that if China ever makes a similar transition it will owe much to the Taiwan example and the Generalissimo's son *Reluctant Regulators* Leo F. Goodstadt,2011-04-01 The 2007-2009 global financial crisis was

predictable and avoidable but American and British regulators chose not to intervene They failed to implement their own

Reluctant Regulators is a scathing indictment of regulatory inertia in the West It provides original insights into the causes of financial crises and pays special attention to China s attempts at reform and Hong Kong s place in China s financial modernization Leo F Goodstadt was chief policy adviser to the Hong Kong Government as head of its Central Policy Unit 1989-1997 and has had an extensive consultancy practice in Asian banking He has written widely on the global financial crisis and on China s economic development

From Mao to Market Andrew H. Wedeman, 2003-07-10 Andrew Wedeman argues that China succeeded in moving from a Maoist command economy to a market economy because the central government failed to prevent local governments from forcing prices to market levels Having partially decontrolled the economy in the early 1980s economic reformers balked at price reform opting instead for a hybrid system wherein commodities had two prices one fixed and one floating Depressed fixed prices led to resource wars as localities battled each other for control over undervalued commodities while inflated consumer goods prices fuelled a headlong investment boom that saturated markets and led to the erection of import barriers Although local rent seeking and protectionism appeared to carve up the economy in reality they had not only pushed prices to market levels and cleared the way for sweeping reforms in the 1980s they had also pushed China past the pitfalls of reform that entrapped other socialist economies

Beyond Tiananmen Robert L.
