The Hotel as Setting in Early Twentieth-century German and Austrian Literature Bettina Matthias, 2006 The employment of the hotel as a setting for literary works of the period and the cultural reasons behind it. As the bourgeois concept of home became problematic after important changes in German-speaking society during the 19th century, many fiction writers chose the literary setting of the hotel to explore the status of the individual and the notions of public and private.
