The Privatisation of European Telecommunications Johan From, Kjell A. Eliassen, 2017-11-28 This international volume presents a comprehensive comparative study of the transformation of the European telecommunications industry from 1990 to the present The book focuses on the old incumbent operators and their dramatic change from state agencies to listed companies It analyzes the liberalization process as well as the corporatization and privatization of these companies The
