Ars amatoria Ovid, 1989 Ovid's *Ars Amatoria* has met with astonishingly varied fortunes down the centuries Ten years after publication the book became a reason or more probably a pretext for the author's banishment from Rome It was removed from public libraries and more recently the poem suffered a virtual embargo in schools and universities This is the first detailed English commentary on any part of the poem Examined afresh it emerges as the wittiest of Ovid's love poems turning upside down the attitudes and conventions of orthodox love elegy The work is full of psychological insight and is richly embroidered with details of contemporary Roman social and political life This new paperback edition intends to bring out the spirit of provocative frivolity which was undeniably meant to irritate Roman traditionalists The text of Kenney's Oxford Classical Text is reproduced and supplemented with a full introduction to the style and historical background the poem as well as with a full commentary and appendices

The author challenges the myth of Latin as a language defined solely by a nominative accusative alignment system through a comprehensive analysis of a wide range of constructions across the history of the language within a single consistent framework. In accordance with the idea of a tension between a syntactically principled system and a semantically oriented system of alignment, the book offers an in-depth exploration of quirky case and alternating patterns of argument realization. The analysis demonstrates that alongside a tendency to neutralize the semantic roles of arguments for syntactic purposes, Latin displays numerous grammatical patterns that do depend on the semantic relation between the arguments and their predicate. The fundamental assumption is that the underlying principles of lexical semantics, i.e. for verbs their Aktionsart and their argument structures, are crucial in accounting for those marked patterns that do not fit the canonical nominative accusative alignment. The book also defends the idea that subjecthood in Latin should be understood as a split relation between a Privileged Syntactic Argument and a pivot distinguishing between coding and behavioral properties of subjects. The findings shed new light on the grammar of Latin and make a strong case for a rich and fully analyzable lexicon in the architecture of grammar.

Obermeier,2023-12-28 This study outlines the history and anatomy of the European apology tradition from the sixth century BCE to 1500 for the first time The study examines the vernacular and Latin tales lyrics epics and prose compositions of Arabic English French German Greek Icelandic Italian Spanish and Welsh authors Three different strands of the apology tradition can be proposed The first and most pervasive strand features apologies to pagan deities and later to God The second most important strand contains literary apologies made to an earthly audience usually of women A third strand occurs more rarely and contains apologies for varying literary offenses that are directed to a more general audience The medieval theory of language privileges an imitation of the Christian master narrative and a hierarchical medieval view of authorship These notions express a medieval philosophical concern about language and its role and therefore the role of the author in cosmic history Despite the fact that women apologize for different purposes and reasons their examples illustrate on yet another level the antifeminist subtext inherent in the entire apology tradition Overall the apology tradition characterized by interauctoriality intertextuality and intratextuality enables self critical authors to refer not only backward but also primarily forward making the medieval apology a progressive strategy that engenders new literature This study would be relevant to all medievalists especially those interested in literature and the history of ideas

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
