between traditional Celtic cultural practices and the concept of well being The volume also provides chapters on Mediaeval Celtic Studies which showcase the work of a number of emerging scholars in the field who examine various aspects of Celtic textuality in Mediaeval Scotland Brittany and Wales Indeed this book gives voice to a number of early career scholars placing them carefully alongside more established scholars in the field in order to show the continuation of established methods of investigation
