

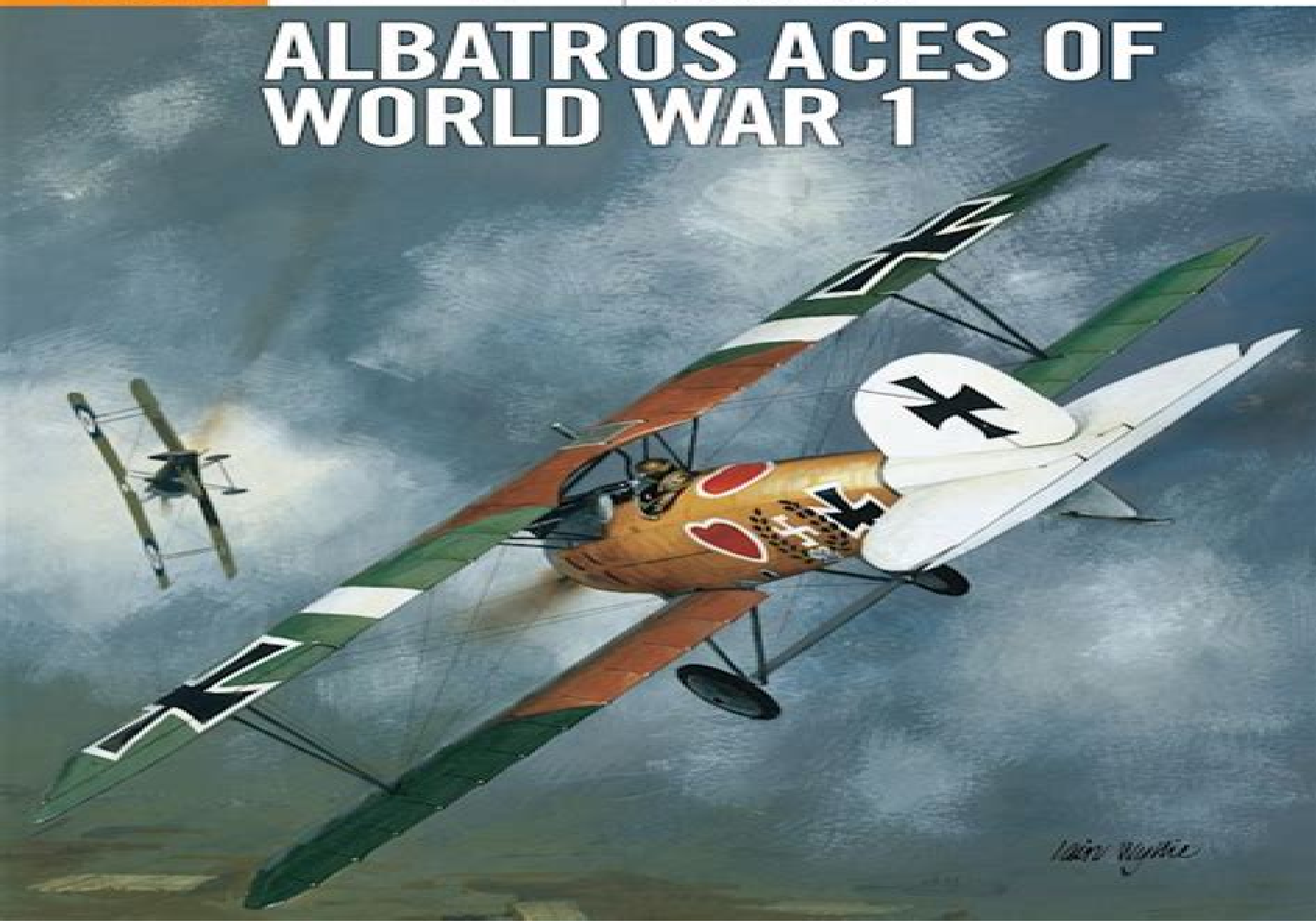

Albatros Aces of World War 1 Norman Franks, 2000-03-25 The Albatros family of fighters were amongst the most effective aircraft employed by the Imperial German Air Service for much of World War 1 with the D III and D Va being flown by most of the 363 pilots who qualified as aces at some point in their often brief careers The Albatros was the scourge of the RFC on the Western Front in 1916-17 with pilots of the calibre of von Richthofen Boelke and Schleich cutting swathes through their opponents Well over 4000 Albatros scouts were built between 1916 and 1918 and they were also extensively used by the Austro Hungarians against Russian Italian and British aircraft until war's end [Albatros Aces of World War 1 Part 2](#) Greg VanWyngarden, 2007-06-19 Nearly every German ace who flew before the summer of 1918 scored victories in Albatros fighters whose introduction coincided with the development of the famous and highly successful Jagdstaffeln the first true German fighter formations which became a critical German air tactic and helped to wrest back air superiority from the Allies After wreaking havoc in the skies over Arras the Albatros was eventually outclassed by succeeding generations of Allied aircraft but still remained the most numerous and ubiquitous of all German fighters in World War I with Albatros biplanes contributing almost two thirds of the German fighters at the front during the Spring Offensive of 1918 This book with its 32 color profiles charts the unique markings and design of one of the most menacingly beautiful fighters of the war Featuring famous and unsung aces a multitude of first hand accounts and original photographs this book offers a fresh view into the experiences of the German pilots who endured a very different kind of war from the troops on the ground While the soldiers confronted the dangers of No Man's Land and faceless slaughter the pilots endured deadly games of cat and mouse in the skies above the trenches *Albatros Aces of World War 1* Norman Franks, 2000 Oversight over tyske piloter Esser der opn ede bem rkelsesv rdige resultater med Albatros flytyper under 1 verdenskrig **Austro-Hungarian Albatros Aces of World War 1** Paolo Varriale, 2012-12-20 A detailed account of how aces of the calibre of Brumowski Kiss and Linke Crawford did their best in their Albatros fighters which often sported colourful and fanciful insignias Austro Hungarian industry produced a series of poor fighter types such as the Phoenix D I and Hansa Brandenburg D I during the early stages of the war and it was not until licence built examples of the battle proven Albatros and D II and D III began to reach Fliegerkompagnien or Fliks in May 1917 that the fortunes of pilots began to look up Unlike the German built Albatrosen the Oeffag aircraft were far more robust than German D IIs and D IIIs They also displayed superior speed climb manoeuvrability and infinitely safer flight characteristics The careful cross checking of Allied sources with Austrian and German records form the basis for a detailed reconstruction of the dogfights fought by the leading aces It will also chart the careers of the Austro Hungarian aces that flew the D II and D III their successes and their defeats with additional information about their personal background and their post war lives in the nations born from the collapse of the Hapsburg Empire [SE 5/5a Aces of World War I](#) Norman Franks, 2013-02-20 The Royal Aircraft Factory SE 5 5a was along with the Sopwith Camel the major British fighting scout of

the last 18 months of the war in France It equipped several major squadrons the first being No 56 Sqn in April 1917 This unit became famous for the number of aces it had among its pilots including Albert Ball James McCudden Geoffrey Bowman Richard Maybery Leonard Barlow Hank Burden and Cyril Crowe In all 26 aces flew the aircraft with No 56 Sqn alone Other well known units were Nos 1 24 29 32 40 41 60 64 2 AFC 74 84 85 and 92 Sqns A number of Victoria Cross winners also flew SE 5 5as namely Ball Mannock McCudden Beauchamp Proctor and Bishop Among the aces no fewer than 20 scored more than 20 victories In all there were almost 100 SE 5 5a aces and a large number of them are profiled in this volume Supporting the text are more than 110 photographs 37 brand new colour artworks and detailed appendices listing every pilot who made ace on the SE 5 5a *American Aces of World War 1* Norman Franks,2001-09-25 American fliers arriving in Europe from September 1917 brought with them no aircraft Instead US units had to obtain machines mainly from the British and French From early 1918 American pilots were issued with SPAD fighters and they never looked back As this volume details the first American trained pilot to become an ace was Lt Douglas Campbell who shot down five German aircraft by the end of May 1918 He was a member of the celebrated 94th Hat in the Ring Aero Squadron which created the bulk of American aces in World War I *Albatros Aces of World War I*. Greg VanWyngarden,2007 **The Austro-Hungarian Forces in World War I (1)** Peter Jung,2003-05-20 The part played in World War I 1914 1918 by the army of the Austro Hungarian Dual Monarchy is little known to English speakers perhaps because the end of the war saw the complete destruction of the Empire Yet it was of central importance providing nearly all Central Powers forces on the Italian front huge numbers on the Russian front seven Army Corps in the Balkans and even a little known contingent in Turkey and Palestine The first half of the story of this complex multi national organization at war is described here in a concise but detailed text supported by data tables and an insignia chart and illustrated with rare photographs and colourful uniform plates *Sopwith Pup Aces of World War 1* Norman Franks,2012-11-20 An illustrated history of the Pup the forerunner of the hugely successful Sopwith Camel and the aces that flew it The first proper British fighting scout the first Pups the Royal Naval Air Service arrived on the Western Front in 1916 Although regarded as a nice aeroplane to fly pilots who used it in combat gained much success during the first half of 1917 The Royal Flying Corps also used the Pup from January 1917 onwards with the final combats with the machine occurring in December of that year This book describes the combat careers of the successful Pup aces how they flew and how they fought *Nieuport Aces of World War 1* Norman Franks,2000-04-25 The French Nieuport company provided the Allied air forces with the first true fighter scout of World War 1 in the shape of the diminutive XI of 1915 Based on the Bebe racer built for the abandoned Gordon Bennett Trophy of the previous year the aircraft utilised a sesquiplane lower wing much smaller than the upper wing arrangement which gave the XI extreme manoeuvrability It was the only scout respected by the all conquering German Fokker E series of 1915 16 and was flown by French British Russian Belgian and Italian aces The XI was replaced from May 1916 onwards by the bigger and more

powerful XVII which proved to be one of the best fighters of World War 1 **Aces of Jagdstaffel 17** Greg VanWyngarden,2013-11-20 Initially formed to assist in the defence of the city of Metz against French bombing raids Royal Prussian Jagdstaffel 17 would go on to become one of the most distinguish German fighter units of World War 1 Its first victory was scored by the pilot whose story is inextricably interwoven with that of his unit the Blue Max recipient Julius Buckler He was largely responsible for inspiring the unit s unique Esprit de Corps expressed in its famous and unique battle cry of Malaula Indeed in its final days the unit gained the nickname Zirkus Buckler or the Buckler Circus Besides Buckler Jasta 17 boasted such aces as Karl Strasser Alfred Fleischer and Christian Donhauser In addition the roster included colourful characters like the successful Jewish airman Jakob Wolff who at over 48 years of age was the oldest German fighter pilot of the war The story of this illustrious unit is told with many first hand accounts by Buckler Fleischer and others as well as dozens of rare archival photos of the unit s beautifully decorated fighter aircraft *Austro-Hungarian Aces of World War 1* Chris Chant,2012-12-20 Featuring illustrations throughout a detailed exploration of the unlikely aces among the Austro Hungarians Starting the war with only 35 aircraft Austro Hungarian industry went on to produce only moderate numbers of poor quality aircraft The fliers of the Austro Hungarian Empire operating on the Serbian and Russian fronts were fortunate at first finding themselves faced by small numbers of aircraft yet more obsolescent than their own Serbia fell in 1915 but when Italy declared war the Austro Hungarians were still faced with a two front war a static front against Italy and a far more fluid one against Russia As Christopher Chant explains in this compact volume Austro Hungarian fighter pilots performed bravely and often very effectively under extremely difficult geographic climatic and operational conditions Raymond Collishaw and the Black Flight Roger Gunn,2013-01-26 As the third highest scoring flying ace among British and colonial pilots in the First World War scoring 60 victories Raymond Collishaw was only surpassed by Billy Bishop and Edward Mannock This book traces his life from humble beginnings in Nanaimo British Columbia to victories in the skies over France **World War I Trench Warfare (1)** Stephen Bull,2002-02-25 Osprey s survey of trench warfare tactics of World War I 1914 1918 The regular armies which marched off to war in 1914 were composed of massed riflemen screened by cavalry and supported by artillery their leaders expected a quick and decisive outcome achieved by sweeping manoeuvre bold leadership and skill at arms Eighteen months later the whole nature of field armies and their tactics had changed utterly In sophisticated trench systems forming a battlefield a few miles wide and 400 miles long conscript armies sheltered from massive long range bombardment wielding new weapons according to new tactical doctrines This first of two richly illustrated studies explains in detail the specifics of that extraordinary transformation complete with ten full colour plates of uniforms and equipment Fighter Aces of the Great War Stephen Wynn,Tanya Wynn,2020-04-30 History has recorded that the first ever powered flight took place at Kitty Hawk in America on 17 December 1903 and was carried out by the Wright brothers Orville and Wilbur who were aircraft designers and manufacturers By the time of the outbreak of the First World War aviation was only

eleven years old The daddy of battlefield warfare until that point in time had been the cavalry a position it maintained even as war was declared on the Western Front Aircraft were not initially seen as an offensive weapon and were instead used by both sides as observation platforms or to take aerial photographs from Even when they were eventually used in an offensive capacity they did not have machine guns attached to them if the crew wanted to open fire then they had to use a pistol or rifle As the war progressed so the use of aircraft changed from being an observational tool to that of a fighter and bomber aircraft something that had never been foreseen at the outbreak of the war The book then looks at the fighter aces from all sides These were pilots who had been credited with shooting or forcing down a minimum of five enemy aircraft of which their were hundreds While some of these aces survived many of them were killed The most famous fighter ace of all is without doubt the German pilot known as the Red Baron Manfred von Richthofen Germany in the Great War Joshua Bilton,2021-04-28 For the Central Powers 1916 was a year of trial and error of successes and failures of innovation and of drastic changes Tactics developed while war aims mutated to suit the inertia of trench warfare Advances were effectively countered with the development of new weaponry or indeed aided by their inclusion Across all fronts whether at home or in Poland citizens and soldiers alike stood fast against Entente forces On the Western Front bitter fighting continued apace To the east the armies of Austro Hungary Germany and Bulgaria battled Entente forces Meanwhile at sea the German High Seas Fleet ambushed the Royal Navy off the coast of Denmark On the Home Front the poor harvest of 1916 coupled with a lack of transport led to a winter of stark deprivation As a consequence the German government introduced what was effectively a system of rationing entitled sharing scarcity While to the south Ottoman forces fought Allied soldiers for control of Kut and Erzurum a fortified trading port in eastern Turkey Germany in the Great War Verdun Somme is the third publication in a five part series In addition to the author s introduction and a chronology of events five hundred contemporary photographs many of which have never before been published in this country are included *Albatros D.III* James F. Miller,2014-03-20 In 1916 German aerial domination once held sway by rotary engined Fokker and Pfalz E type wing warping monoplanes had been lost to the more nimble French Nieuports and British DH 2s which not only out flew the German fighters but were present in greater numbers Born from experience calls from German fighter pilots requested that rather than compete with the maneuverability of these adversaries new single engine machines should be equipped with higher horsepower engines and armed with two rather than the then standard single machine gun The Robert Thelen led Albatros design bureau set to work on what became the Albatros D I and D II and by April 1916 they had developed a sleek yet rugged machine that featured the usual Albatros semi monocoque wooden construction and employed a 160hp Mercedes D III engine with power enough to equip the aeroplane with two forward firing machine guns In all 500 D IIIs and 840 D III OAW s were produced and saw heavy service throughout 1917 *Fokker Dr I Aces of World War 1* Norman Franks,2001-08-25 Undoubtedly the most famous fighter type to see service on either side during World War 1 the Fokker Dr I was a revelation when it entered service

on the western front in 1917 Manfred von Richthofen's JG 1 circus was the first Jasta to completely re-equip with the new fighter and in the skilled hands of its numerous aces the Dr I proved a formidable opponent. The Dr I remained in service on the Western Front until replaced by the superior Fokker D VII in May 1918. Just weeks prior to that, however, Germany's leading ace, the great Red Baron, had been killed at the controls of a Dr I.
