**A Visit From Saint Nicholas** Clement Moore, F. O. C. Darley, 2023-12-07 A Visit from St Nicholas more commonly known as The Night Before Christmas and Twas the Night Before Christmas from its first line is a poem first published anonymously in 1823 and later attributed to Clement Clarke Moore who claimed authorship in 1837 The poem has been called arguably the best known verses ever written by an American and is largely responsible for some of the conceptions of Santa Claus from the mid nineteenth century to today It has had a massive impact on the history of Christmas gift giving Before the poem gained wide popularity American ideas had varied considerably about Saint Nicholas and other Christmastide visitors A Visit from St Nicholas eventually was set to music and has been recorded by many artists On the night of Christmas Eve a family are settling down to sleep when the father is disturbed by noises on the lawn outside Looking out the window he sees Saint Nicholas in an air borne sleigh pulled by eight reindeer After landing his sleigh on the roof Saint Nicholas enters the house down the chimney carrying a sack of toys The father watches his visitor fill the stockings hanging by the fireplace and laughs to himself They share a conspiratorial moment before Saint Nicholas bounds up the chimney again As he flies away he wishes a Happy Christmas to all and to all a good night
