Chatelain,2024-03-21 Across North America s periphery unknown and overlooked Civil War campaigns were waged over whether the United States or Confederacy would dominate lands mines and seaborne transportation networks of North America s mineral wealth The U S needed this wealth to stabilize their wartime economy while the Confederacy sought to expand their own treasury Confederate armies advanced to seize the West and its gold and silver reserves while warships steamed to intercept Panama route ships transporting bullion from California to Panama to New York United States forces responded by expelling Confederate incursions and solidified territorial control by combating Indigenous populations and enacting laws encouraging frontier settlement The U S Navy patrolled key ports convoyed treasure ships and integrated continent wide intelligence networks in the ultimate game of cat and mouse This book examines the campaigns to control North America s mineral wealth linking the Civil War s military naval political diplomatic and economic elements Included are the hemispheric land and sea adventures involving tycoon Cornelius Vanderbilt admiral and explorer Charles Wilkes renowned sea captain Raphael Semmes General Henry Sibley cowboy and mountain man Kit Carson Indigenous leaders Mangas Coloradas and Geronimo writer and miner Mark Twain and Mormon leader Brigham Young **Soldiers in the Southwest Borderlands, 1848-1886** Janne Lahti,2017-04-13 Most military biographies focus on officers many of whom left diaries or wrote letters throughout their lives and careers This collection offers new perspectives by focusing on the lives of enlisted soldiers from a variety of cultural and racial backgrounds Comprised of ten biographies Soldiers in the Southwest Borderlands showcases the scholarship of experts who have mined military records descendants recollections genealogical sources and even folklore to tell common soldiers stories The essays examine enlisted soldiers cross cultural interactions and dynamic situational identities They illuminate the intersections of class culture and race in the nineteenth century Southwest The men who served under U S or Mexican flags and on the payrolls of the federal government or as state or territorial volunteers represented most of the major ethnicities in the West Hispanics African Americans Indians American born Anglos and recent European immigrants and many moved fluidly among various social and ethnic groups For example though usually described as an Apache scout Mickey Free was born to Mexican parents raised by an American stepfather adopted by an Apache father given an Irish name and was ultimately categorized by federal authorities as an Irish Mexican White Mountain Apache George Goldsby a former slave of mixed ancestry served as a white soldier in the Union army during the Civil War and then served twelve years as a Buffalo Soldier in the all black Tenth U S Cavalry He also claimed some American Indian ancestry and was rumored to have crossed the Mexican border to fight alongside Pancho Villa What motivated these soldiers Some

were patriots and adventurers Others were destitute and had few other options Enlisted men received little professional training and possibilities for advancement were few Many of these men witnessed underwent or inflicted extreme violence some of it personal and much of it related to excruciating military campaigns Spotlighting ordinary men who usually appear on the margins of history the biographical essays collected here tell the stories of soldiers in the complex world of the Southwest after the U S Mexican War

Draper, 2012-05-07 Having been born and raised on the Missouri River at Atchison Kansas and having the ghosts of the Civil War about me constantly I have been passionately interested in the Civil War as long as I can remember The Victorian and antebellum homes with servant quarters still behind them the wooded bluffs and caves where escaped slaves were hidden and the mystique of the Missouri River area itself have maintained this feeling of the war for me My mother's immediate family was from the Missouri River bottoms on the Missouri side and my father's immediate family was from rural Atchison on the Kansas side From my incomplete and somewhat misinformed family and formal history education I assumed for most of my life that my mother's family was Confederate in its leanings and that my father's family was Union I was unaware that the town and county's namesake Sen David Rice Atchison was from Missouri and had much Pro Slavery activity No effort has ever been made to change the town's name since the war No Confederate tie to him was taught in any of my classes in school

A Failed Vision of Empire Daniel J. Burge, 2022-05 Since the early twentieth century historians have traditionally defined manifest destiny as the belief that the United States was destined to expand from coast to coast This generation of historians has posed manifest destiny as a unifying ideology of the nineteenth century one that was popular and pervasive and ultimately fulfilled in the late 1840s when the United States acquired the Pacific Coast However the story of manifest destiny was never quite that simple In *A Failed Vision of Empire* Daniel J. Burge examines the belief in manifest destiny over the nineteenth century by analyzing contested moments in the continental expansion of the United States arguing that the ideology was ultimately unsuccessful By examining speeches plays letters diaries newspapers and other sources Burge reveals how Americans debated the wisdom of expansion challenged expansionists and disagreed over what the boundaries of the United States should look like *A Failed Vision of Empire* is the first work to capture the messy complicated and yet far more compelling story of manifest destiny's failure debunking in the process one of the most pervasive myths of modern American history

Terror on the Santa Fe Trail Doug Hocking, 2019-09-20 Winner of the 2020 Will Rogers Medallion Award for Western Nonfiction In the 1840s and 50s the Jicarilla Apache were the terror of the Santa Fe Trail and the Rio Arriba They repeatedly clashed with the cavalry and raided wagon trains and there was bad blood between the band and the Army after the Battle of San Pasqual when they were on opposite sides during the Mexican American War In 1854 as traffic was on the increase along the historic trade route the Jicarilla soundly defeated the 1st United States Dragoons in the Battle of Cieneguilla Cieneguilla was the worst defeat of the US Army in the West up to that time and it was just one of the first major battles between the US Army and Apache forces during the Ute Wars According to one version of events the 60 dragoons under the direction of a Lt Davidson had engaged in an unauthorized attack on the Jicarilla while they were out on patrol Others claimed that the Jicarilla either ambushed the Army or taunted them into attack Kit Carson who was agent for the Jicarilla would defend Davidson's actions and after this fight he served as a scout against the Jicarilla Much like the Sioux defeat of Custer at Little Big Horn the Jicarilla's victory over the Army led to retribution and disaster The Jicarilla were defeated and faded from memory before the Civil War These are the events that brought them to ruin

Riding for the Lone Star Nathan A.
