The first blood bank is soon operating in Chicago During World War II researchers driven by battlefield needs break down blood into usable components that are more easily stored and transported This fractionation process accomplished by a Harvard team produces a host of pharmaceuticals setting the stage for the global marketplace to come Plasma precisely because it can be made into long lasting drugs is shipped and traded for profit today it is a 5 billion business.
