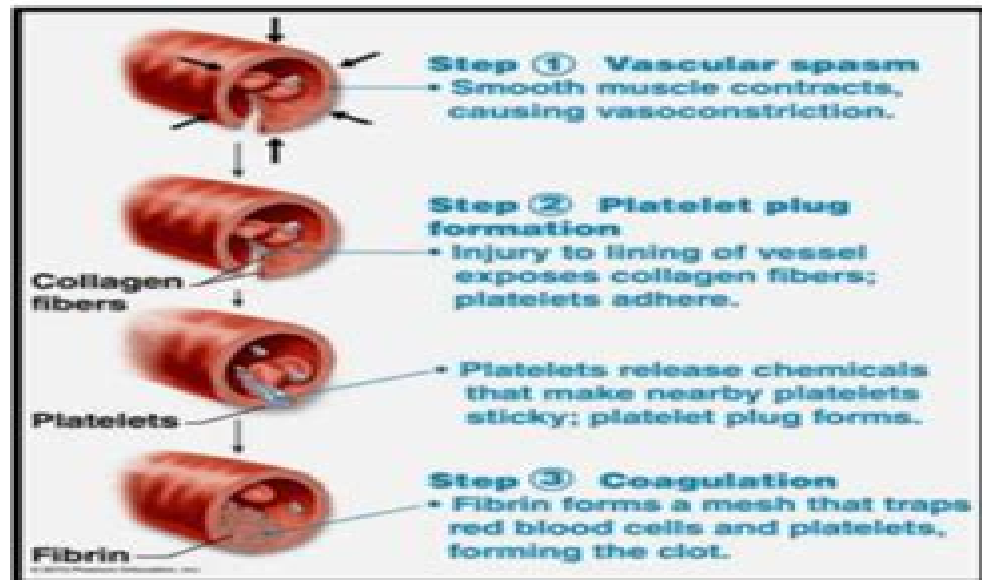


HEMOSTASIS

❖ Hemostasis: (Stoppage of blood flow after damage)

- A break in a blood vessel stimulates hemostasis, a fast, localized response to reduce blood loss through clotting.

1. **Vascular spasms** are the immediate vasoconstriction response to blood vessel injury slows the flow of blood and thus helps to limit blood loss.
2. **Platelet Plug Formation:** When a blood vessel is damaged, the blood is exposed to collagen fibers in the basement membrane of the vessel and the platelets become sticky and spiky, adhering to each other and the damaged vessel wall. Once attached, other platelets are attracted to the site of injury, activating a positive feedback loop for clot formation.
3. **Coagulation, or blood clotting,** is a multi-step process (clotting cascade) in which blood is transformed from a liquid to a gel. Factors that promote clotting are called **clotting factors** (These factors are proteins that exist in the blood in an inactive state), those that inhibit clot formation are called **anticoagulants**.
