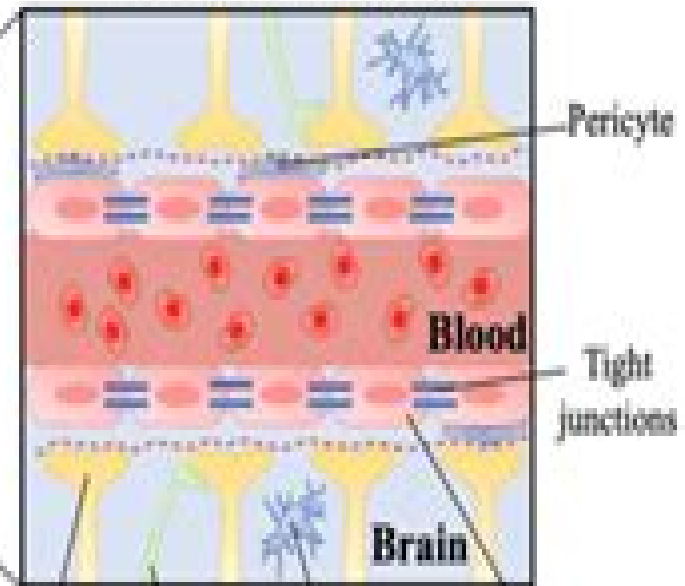
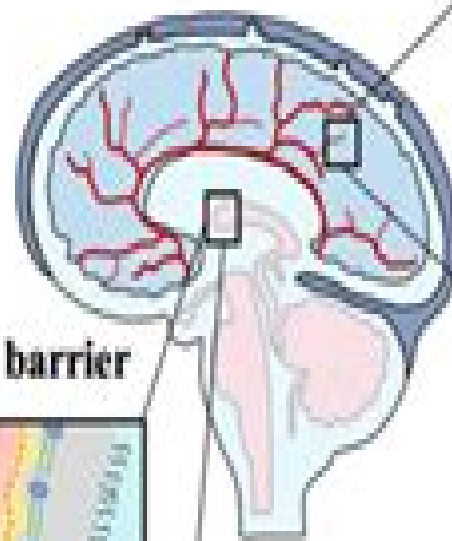
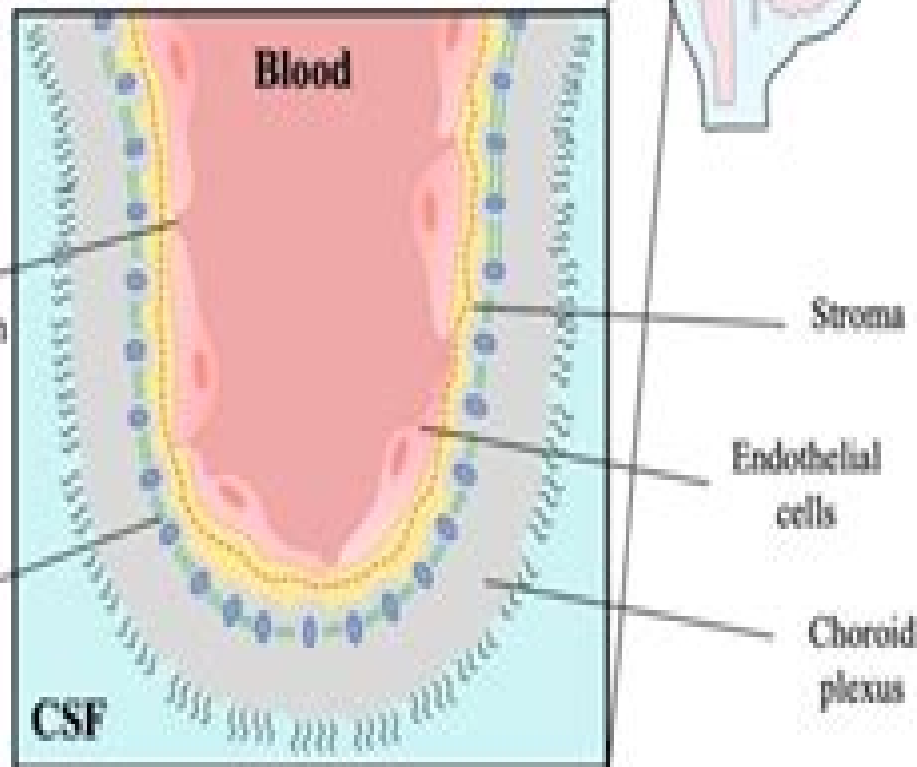

Neuwelt, 2013-11-11 Understanding the structure and function of the blood brain barrier BBB and recognizing its clinical relevance require a concert of scientific disciplines applied from a view point of integrative physiology rather than from only molecular or analytical approaches It is this broad scope that is emphasized in this book In my opinion four original contributions define the field as it exists today The first a monograph by Broman 1 entitled *The Permeability of the Cerebrospinal Vessels in Normal and Pathological Conditions* was the model for many subsequent clinical and 3 experimental studies on BBB pathology Second experiments by Davson summarized in his book entitled *Physiology of the Ocular and Cerebrospinal Fluids* indicated that passive entry of nonelectrolytes into brain from blood is governed largely by their lipid 4 solubility This research supported the original suggestion by Gesell and Hertzman that cerebral membranes have the semipermeability properties of cell membranes The modern era of the barrier was introduced with the 1965 paper by Crone 2 entitled *Facilitated transfer of glucose from blood to brain tissue* This paper identified stereospecific facilitated transport of glucose as part of a system of regulatory barrier properties at a time when only a barrier to passive diffusion had been contemplated

Finally the 1967 paper by Reese and Kamovsky 11 entitled Fine structural localization of a blood brain barrier to exogenous peroxidase sited the barrier at the continuous layer of cerebrovascular endothelial cells which are connected by tight junctions
