shows that these more recent writers advocated a literary nationalism that was based on a modified Boasian anthropology and that laid the pluralist grounds for our current conception of literary multiculturalism Ultimately Douglas s unified field theory of multicultural literature brings together divergent African American Asian American Mexican American and Native American literary traditions into one story of how we moved from thinking about groups as races to thinking about groups as cultures and then back again
