The Book Unbound Siân Echard, Stephen Partridge, Stephen Bradford Partridge, 2004-01-01 Contemporaries of Erasmus contains biographical information about more than 1900 people mentioned in the correspondence and other writings of Erasmus This paperback edition is a reprint of the three volume set published between 1985 and 1987 The volumes have been combined into a single volume without any editorial changes to provide a manageable and affordable edition of a magisterial work The remarkable breadth of Erasmus contacts throughout his life is reflected in this unique volume Differing substantially from the national biographical dictionaries that restrict themselves to major figures Contemporaries of Erasmus combines the famous with the obscure popes and politicians artists and poets knights and theologians covering every individual mentioned whose death occurred after the year 1450 Well known figures include Martin Luther King Henry VIII Machiavelli Popes Nicholas V and Peter IV and Emperor Charles V Dipping into the pages of this fully illustrated volume will intrigue and delight the casual reader but the combined volume will also be an indispensable tool for those who have searched in vain for a biographical dictionary of the Renaissance and the Reformation **New Canadian Library** Janet Friskney, 2015-05-07 In the mid 1950s much Canadian literature was out of print making it relatively inaccessible to readers including those studying the subject in schools and universities When English professor Malcolm Ross approached Toronto publisher Jack McClelland in 1952 to propose a Canadian literary reprint series it was still the accepted wisdom among publishers that Canadian literature was of insufficient interest to the educational market to merit any great publishing risks Eventually convinced by Ross that a latent market for Canadian literary reprints did indeed exist McClelland Stewart launched the New Canadian Library NCL series in 1958 with Ross as its general editor In 2008 the NCL will celebrate a half century of publication In New Canadian Library Janet B Friskney takes the reader through the early history of the NCL series focusing on the period up to 1978 when Malcolm Ross retired as general editor A wealth of archival resources published reviews and the NCL volumes themselves are used to survey the working relationship between Ross and McClelland as well as the collaborative participation of those who through the middle decades of the twentieth century were committed to studying and nurturing Canada's literary heritage To place the New Canadian Library in its proper historical context Friskney examines the simultaneous development of Canadian literary studies as a legitimate area of research and teaching in academe and acknowledges the NCL as a milestone in Canadian publishing history *Dominion and Agency* Eli MacLaren, 2011-10-08 The 1867 Canadian confederation brought with it expectations of a national literature which a rising class of local printers hoped to supply Reforming copyright law in the imperial context proved impossible and Canada became a prime market for foreign publishers instead The subsequent development of the agency system of exclusive publisher importers became a defining feature of Canadian trade publishing for most of the twentieth century In *Dominion and Agency* Eli MacLaren analyses the struggle for copyright reform and the creation of a national literature using previously

Guillaume de Machaut 1300 1377 was the master poet of fourteenth century France He established models for much of the vernacular poetry written by subsequent generations and he was instrumental in institutionalizing the lay reader In particular his longest and most important work the *Voir dit* calls attention to the coexistence of public and private reading practices through its intensely hybrid form sixty three poems and ten songs invite an oral performance while forty six private prose letters as well as elaborate illustration and references to its own materiality promote a physical encounter with the book In *Controlling Readers* Deborah McGrady uses Machaut's corpus as a case study to explore the impact of lay literacy on the culture of late medieval Europe Arguing that Machaut and his bookmakers were responding to contemporary debates surrounding literacy McGrady first accounts for the formal invention of the lay reader in medieval art and literature then analyses Machaut and his bookmakers innovative use of both narrative and bibliographical devices to try to control the responses of his readers and promote intimate and sensual reading practices in place of the more common public performances of court culture McGrady's erudite and exhaustive study is key to understanding Machaut his works and his influence on the history of reading in the fourteenth century and beyond **The Literary Legacy of the Macmillan**

Today Ovid's famous work is one of the touchstones of ancient literature but we have only a handful of scraps and quotations to show how the earliest medieval readers received and discussed the poems until the Munich Bayerische Staatsbibliothek clm 4610. This commentary which dates from around the year 1100 is the first systematic study of the Metamorphoses founding a tradition of scholarly study that extends to the present day. Despite its significance this medieval commentary has never before been published or analysed as a whole. Böckerman's groundbreaking work includes a critical edition of the entire manuscript together with a lucid English translation and a rigorous and stimulating introduction which sets the work in its historical geographical and linguistic contexts with precision and clarity while offering a rigorous analysis of its form and function.
