early conservation movement

**Physicians for the People** Jack D. Ellis, 2025 African Americans have always fared worse than whites in enjoying the benefits of material progress and medical discovery Black sociologist and civil rights leader W E B Du Bois argued that high mortality rates among Black people were rooted not in racial inferiority but in the conditions of life a fact illustrated by tuberculosis which was three times higher among Blacks than whites as well as the infant mortality rate for nonwhite children which was 149.7 deaths per 1,000 births as opposed to 92.8 per 1,000 for white children In *Physicians for the People: Black Doctors and the Struggle for Health Care Equality in Alabama 1870-1970* Jack D. Ellis argues that the post-Civil War lives of Black physicians, dentists, pharmacists, nurses, and midwives hold special significance in this regard illuminating both the causes of health care disparities among African Americans and the reasons for their continued underrepresentation in the medical professions At the center of Ellis's study are African American doctors who practiced in Alabama between the late 1870s and the Civil Rights movement of the 1960s During those years a total of 241 Black medical

graduates passed their licensing examinations and opened offices in the state Ellis poses these questions What were their geographical and family origins and why had they been attracted to the study of medicine Where had they trained and how did they manage to function as professionals in a climate of racial oppression What was their relationship to white doctors practicing in their communities and how did they compensate for their systematic exclusion from local medical societies and hospitals To identify Alabama's Black doctors of the past Ellis first turns to the annual membership lists of each medical society in the state's sixty-seven counties where the names of licensed practitioners who were not members also appeared followed by the abbreviation col for colored a routine practice of the era that only ceased in 1965 Ellis then compiles oral histories from various interviews with physicians dentists and family members who were able to provide information on conditions affecting African American medical practice in Alabama between the 1930s and 1970s Portions of these oral histories include doctors' recollections of childhood family life and early education and their evolving interest in the sciences which occurred despite the weakness of libraries and laboratories in Black schools Also included are the doctors' memories of medical training and the problems they encountered once in practice from the wholesale poverty of their patients to the parallel worlds in which Black and white practitioners pursued their calling as well as their accounts of the years spent trying to gain admission to Alabama's county medical societies where membership was required to be admitted to hospital staffs and to pursue specialty training As Ellis shows this proved to be the hardest battle of all even though Black doctors had passed the same licensing examinations as white doctors From their first appearance in Alabama Black physicians hoped to cooperate with their white peers but their efforts went largely ignored white doctors tended not only to share the racist norms of their time but often exceeded them Black doctors being denied hospital training came at an enormous price to their careers and to the health of the state's Black citizens the effects of which can still be seen today in statistical data which shows that Black doctors face a disproportionate number of sanctions when compared to white physicians and that the maternal and infant mortality rates for Black women and children are still much higher than their white counterparts

Andrew Carnegie Joseph Frazier Wall, 1970 This masterful biography of a giant of American industry the first full life of Andrew Carnegie in more than a generation triumphantly reveals every aspect of the man's complex personality and fabulous career So varied were Carnegie's activities in industry politics education philanthropy and pacificism that his life encompasses much of the general history of the United States and of Great Britain down to the outbreak of World War I Wall is particularly successful in capturing the excitement of America's dynamic period of business expansion in the generation after the Civil War Carnegie the man remains at the center of the book impulsive haughty idealistic warm loyal and shrewd and the drama of his life from telegraph boy to millionaire philanthropist is emphasized His Scottish background is thoroughly investigated Wall is concerned throughout with Carnegie's attempts to reconcile his spectacular business success and position in the American plutocracy with the egalitarian and Radical Chartist ideas of his family and youth Carnegie's

letterbooks and early business files in the possession of the United States Steel Corporation and until now inaccessible to historians were made available to the author This vital and valuable collection of records is unsurpassed in its revelation of how Carnegie s own corporations operated and also as an actual example of the development of a great American industry Wall also consulted the huge collection of Carnegie material in the Library of Congress and the papers of Carnegie s business secretary Robert Franks Carnegie s daughter Mrs Roswell Miller was kind enough to allow Wall to read the private correspondence between Andrew Carnegie and his wife Louise also not previously available to scholars The epic highly charged relationship between Carnegie and Henry Clay Frick emerges brilliantly and the story of Carnegie s ventures in oil railroad building and financing bridge building telegraphy and iron and steel is clearly and fully presented The book gives place also to a myriad of fascinating figures in America and Europe including William Gladstone Matthew Arnold and Herbert Spencer in England and J P Morgan George Pullman Mark Twain William Jennings Bryan Booker T Washington and Presidents Lincoln McKinley Theodore Roosevelt and Wilson in America It has much to say also about the impact of the Civil War on American industrialism industrial statesmen and robber barons and the influence of Social Darwinism on the business community This rounded honest biography while compassionate does not hesitate to call Carnegie to task for some of his financial dealings his often arbitrary personal relationships and his occasional hypocrisy or to show him at his worst when dealing with the tragic Homestead strike of 1892 But the reader takes from the book a full understanding of why to many Americans Carnegie s death meant the end of an era in American history

**Been Coming through Some Hard Times**  
Jack Glazier, 2013-03-30 This book is a unique study of race and racism across two centuries in the hinterland of the upper South Its implications are at once depressingly familiar and distinctly fresh W Fitzhugh Brundage author of Lynching in the New South Georgia and Virginia 1880 1930 From the earliest days when slaves were brought to western Kentucky the descendants of both slaves and slave owners in Hopkinsville Kentucky have continued to inhabit the same social and historic space Part ethnography and part historical narrative Been Coming through Some Hard Times offers a penetrating look at this southern town and the surrounding counties delving particularly into the ways in which its inhabitants have remembered and publicly represented race relations in their community Neither Deep South nor Appalachian this western Kentucky borderland presented unique opportunities for African American communities and also deep lasting tensions with powerful whites Glazier conducted fieldwork in Hopkinsville for some ten months examining historical evidence oral histories and the racialized hierarchy found in the final resting places of black and white citizens His analysis shows how structural inequality continues to prevail in Hopkinsville The book s ethnographic vignettes of worship services school policy disputes segregated cemeteries a dressing like our ancestors day at an elementary school and black family reunions poignantly illustrate the ongoing debate over the public control of memory Ultimately the book critiques the lethargy of white Americans who still fail to recognize the persistence of white privilege and therefore stunt the development of a truly multicultural society Glazier s

personal investment in this subject is clear. *Been Coming through Some Hard Times* began as an exploration of the life of James Bass, an African American who settled in Hopkinsville in 1890 and whose daughter Idella Bass cared for Glazier as a child. Her remarkable life profoundly influenced Glazier and led him to investigate her family's roots in the town. This personal dimension makes Glazier's ethnohistorical account especially nuanced and moving. Here is a uniquely revealing look at how the racial injustices of the past impinge quietly but insidiously upon the present in a distinctive understudied region.

The concluding chapter details the founding of the West Raonoke Missionary Baptist Association from the Roanoke Missionary Baptist Association. Dr. Boone has taken the Bataan from others who knew that this important historical contribution needed to be gathered, appreciated, shared, and celebrated for a job well done. Unfortunately, no one was able to consistently pursue this great endeavor before Dr. Boone's extensive and exhaustive work represented here. Massive in its scope, the volume guides the reader in a comprehensive and challenging look at the origin and the significance of the Roanoke Missionary Baptist Association and the importance of the Founding Fathers and the work with the North Carolina and Virginia abolitionist. higher education which especially blossomed after the end of the Civil War and through the New South Era from 1865 to 1930 This wide ranging book chronicles the founding and growth of Nashville s institutions of higher education and their impressive impact on the city region and nation at large Local colleges and universities also heavily influenced Nashville s brand of modernity as evidenced by the construction of a Parthenon replica the centerpiece of the 1897 Centennial Exposition By the turn of the twentieth century Vanderbilt University had become one of the country s premier private schools while nearby Peabody College was a leading teacher training institution Nashville also became known as a center for the education of African Americans Fisk University joined the ranks of the nation s most prestigious black liberal arts universities while Meharry Medical College emerged as one of the country s few training centers for African American medical professionals Following the agricultural industrial model Tennessee A David Lipscomb College the instructional arm of the Church of Christ and Roger Williams University which trained black men and women as teachers and preachers made important contributions to the higher educational landscape In sum Nashville was distinguished not only by the quantity of its schools but by their quality Linking these institutions to the progressive and educational reforms of the era Mary Ellen Pethel also explores their impact in shaping Nashville s expansion on changing gender roles and on leisure activity in the city which included the rise and popularity of collegiate sports In her conclusion she shows that Nashville s present day reputation as a dynamic place to live learn and work is due in no small part to the role that higher education continues to play in the city s growth and development MARY ELLEN PETHEL is the archivist and a member of the Social Science Department at Harpeth Hall School in Nashville At Belmont University also in Nashville Dr Pethel is a Global Leadership Studies Fellow and teaches in the Honors Department
