**Albert Camus's "The New Mediterranean Culture"** Neil Foxlee, 2010 This book was shortlisted for the R H Gapper prize 2011 On 8 February 1937 the 23 year old Albert Camus gave an inaugural lecture for a new Maison de la culture or community arts centre in Algiers Entitled La nouvelle culture mediterrannee The New Mediterranean Culture Camus's lecture has been interpreted in radically different ways while some critics have dismissed it as an incoherent piece of juvenilia others see it as key to understanding his future development as a thinker whether as the first expression of his so called Mediterranean humanism or as an early indication of what is seen as his essentially colonial mentality These various interpretations are based on reading the text of The New Mediterranean Culture in a single context whether that of Camus's life and work as a whole of French discourses on the Mediterranean or of colonial Algeria and French discourses on that country By contrast this study argues that Camus's lecture and in principle any historical text needs to be seen in a multiplicity of contexts discursive and otherwise if readers are to understand properly what its author was doing in writing it Using Camus's lecture as a case study the book provides a detailed theoretical and practical justification of this multi contextualist approach

**The Atheist's Creed** Michael Palmer, 2010-10-29 In The Atheist's Creed a prominent and widely read contemporary philosopher Dr Michael Palmer presents the most comprehensive anthology of the major philosophical arguments for atheism now before the public While the so called new atheism of Richard Dawkins and others has attracted considerable publicity it is these philosophical arguments that have down the ages provided the principal landmarks in the unfolding and increasingly widespread belief that no God exists Using a combination of extracts detailed introductions biographies and extensive bibliographies the author guides the reader through the history of atheism from the time of the early Greeks down to the present day In this analysis particular attention is given to the writings of Hume Nietzsche Marx and Freud The Atheist's Creed requires no specialist knowledge of philosophy Each chapter is structured around a single theme and the various authors coordinated to allow the full force of the particular atheistic argument to emerge The result is a compelling and powerful assessment of the case for atheism which will be essential and fascinating reading for student and non student alike and for all those concerned with the fundamental question whether or not there is a God

Dark Feelings, Grim Thoughts Robert C. Solomon, 2006-07-27 In the same spirit as his most recent book Living With Nietzsche and his earlier study In the Spirit of Hegel Robert Solomon turns

to the existential thinkers Albert Camus and Jean Paul Sartre in an attempt to get past the academic and political debates and focus on what is truly interesting and valuable about their philosophies Solomon makes the case that despite their very different responses to the political questions of their day Camus and Sartre were both fundamentally moralists and their philosophies cannot be understood apart from their deep ethical commitments He focuses on Sartre's early pre 1950 work and on Camus's best known novels *The Stranger* *The Plague* and *The Fall* Throughout Solomon makes the important point that their shared interest in phenomenology was much more important than their supposed affiliation with existentialism Solomon's reappraisal will be of interest to anyone who is still or ever has been fascinated by these eccentric but monumental figures

**The Enigma of Good and Evil: The Moral Sentiment in Literature** Anna-Teresa Tymieniecka, 2006-08-27 Striking toward peace and harmony the human being is ceaselessly torn apart in personal social national life by wars feuds inequities and intimate personal conflicts for which there seems to be no respite Does the human condition in interaction with others imply a constant adversity Or is this conflict owing to an interior or external factor of evil governing our attitudes and conduct toward the other person To what criteria should I refer for appreciation judgment direction concerning my attitudes and my actions as they bear on the well being of others At the roots of these questions lies human experience which ought to be appropriately clarified before entering into speculative abstractions of the ethical theories and precepts Literature which in its very gist dwells upon disentangling in multiple perspective the peripeteia of our life experience offers us a unique field of source material for moral and ethical investigations Literature brings preeminently to light the Moral Sentiment which pervades our life with others our existence tout court Being modulated through the course of our experiences the Moral Sentiment sustains the very sense of literature and of personal human life Tymieniecka

Musila, 2022-08-15 *The Plague Years* collects scholarly and essayistic reflections on literary visual and sonic representations of the COVID 19 and other pandemics These are placed alongside poetry and short fiction written in the first two years of quarantine or isolation This range expresses the intellectual and imaginative struggle and ingenuity entailed in coming to terms with the rampant spread of disease and its emotional cultural and political consequences The contributions are from diverse contexts Africa from Egypt to South Africa China Japan the US and Scandinavia They consider some of the array of contemporary engagements poems translated from Mandarin about the traumas of the frontline Chinese calligraphic poetry printed on cartons of PPE comments on the literary history of representing epidemics and pandemics political analyses of the post truth present and the role of life writing and gaming in an interrupted world Given the generative and creative obliquity of many of its parts this collection shifts how one thinks about the diseased present and the archival pasts on which it draws The chapters in this book were originally published as a special issue of *English Studies in Africa*

**Antonio Gramsci** James Joll, 1978 Antonio Francesco Gramsci 1891 1937 was an Italian Marxist philosopher and communist politician He wrote on political theory sociology and linguistics He attempted to break from the economic determinism of traditional Marxist thought and so is considered a key neo Marxist 3 He was a founding member and one time leader of the Communist Party of Italy and was imprisoned by Benito Mussolini's Fascist regime He wrote more than 30 notebooks and 3 000 pages of history and analysis during his imprisonment His Prison Notebooks are considered a highly original contribution to 20th century political theory Gramsci drew insights from varying sources not only other Marxists but also thinkers such as Niccol Machiavelli Vilfredo Pareto Georges Sorel and Benedetto Croce The notebooks cover a wide range of topics including Italian history and nationalism the French Revolution fascism Fordism civil society folklore religion and high and popular culture [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Antonio\\_Gramsci](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Antonio_Gramsci)
