predictor of architectural fame She offers the intriguing hypothesis that what is transferred in the relationship is not a particular style or approach but rather the courage and self confidence to be true to one s own vision Perhaps she says this is the case in all the arts American Architects and the Mechanics of Fame is sure to provoke thought and comment in architecture and other creative fields
