Art & Its Shadow Mario Perniola, 2004-05-01 Art and its Shadow is an extraordinary analysis of the state and meaning of contemporary art and film Ranging across the work of Andy Warhol cyberpunk Wim Wenders Derek Jarman thinking on difference and the possibility of a philosophical cinema Mario Perniola examines the latest and most disturbing tendencies in art Perniola explores how art notably in posthumanism psychotic realism and extreme art continues to survive despite the hype of the art market and the world of mass communication and reproduction He argues that the meaning of art in the modern world no longer lies in aesthetic value above the art work nor in popular taste below the art work but beside the artwork in the shadow created by both the art establishment and the world of mass communications In this shadow is what is left out of account by both market and mass media the difficulty of art a knowledge that can never be fully revealed and a new aesthetic future

The Shadow and Its Shadow is a classic collection of writings by the Surrealists on their mad love of moviegoing The forty odd theoretical polemical and poetical re visions of the seventh art in this anthology document Surrealism s scandalous and nonreductive take on film Writing between 1918 and 1977 the essayists include such names as Andr eacute Breton Louis Aragon Robert Desnos Salvador Dal iacute Luis Bu ntilde uel and man Ray as well as many of the less famous though equally fascinating figures of the movement Paul Hammond s introduction limns the history of Surrealist cinemania highlighting how these revolutionary poets artists and philosophers sifted the silt of commercial often Hollywood cinema for the odd fleck of gold the windfall movie that somehow slipping past the censor questioned the dominant order Such prospecting pivoted around the notion of lyrical behavior as depicted on the screen and as lived in the movie house The representation of such behavior led the Surrealists to valorize the manifest content of such denigrated genres as silent and sound comedy romantic melodrama film noir horror movies As to lived experience moviegoing Surrealists looked to the spectacle s latent meaning reading films as the unwitting providers of redemptive sequences that could be mentally clipped out of their narrative context and inserted into daily life there to provoke new adventures Hammond s book is a reminder of the wealth and range of surrealist writings on the cinema T he work represented here is still challenging and genuinely eccentric locating itself in an ethic of love reverie and revolt Sight Breton which was published by City Lights

This groundbreaking book provides a major reassessment of the history and significance of cubism David Cottington examines the cubist movement and sets it within the complex political economic and cultural forces of pre World War I France Cubism as a part of the Parisian artistic avant garde played an integral role in the turbulent Belle Epoque The author focuses on cubisms relation to the particular discourses of nationalism aestheticism gender the social purpose of art that gave meaning to the experience of modernity in Paris in the decade before the war In Part I of the book the author discusses the cubist conjuncture the years that followed the collapse of the Bloc des Gauches The Bloc more than a parliamentary alliance represented an effort of collaboration between the liberal middle class and sectors of the working class led by Parisian intellectuals and artists future cubists among them In the wake of the Blocs failure workers withdrew into trade unionism and artists into aesthetic avant gardism Cottington analyzes this consolidation of the artistic avant garde its relation to the expanding dealer centered art market and the dominant and counter discourses of the day In Part II he considers specific aspects of cubist art and the cubist movement from the conservative modernism of the paintings of Le Fauconnier and Gleizes to the aestheticism of Picassos papiers collés to the collective architectural and interior design project of the cubist house These examples and others Cottington concludes reveal cubism as a contradictory and unstable constellation of interests and practices sometimes complicit with dominant social and political forces sometimes opposed to them but in every case shaped by them

Elements of Descriptive Geometry Albert Ensign Church, 1872 **The Cinema and Its Shadow** Alice Maurice, 2013-03-15 The Cinema and Its Shadow argues that race has defined the cinematic apparatus since the earliest motion pictures especially at times of technological transition In particular this work explores how racial difference became central to the resolving of cinematic problems the stationary camera narrative form realism the synchronization of image and sound and perhaps most fundamentally the immaterial image the cinema's shadow which figures both the material reality of the screen image and its racist past Discussing early race subjects Alice Maurice demonstrates that these films influenced cinematic narrative in lasting ways by helping to determine the relation between stillness and motion spectacle and narrative drive The book examines how motion picture technology related to race embodiment and authenticity at specific junctures in cinema's development including the advent of narratives feature films and sound In close readings of such films as *The Cheat* *Shadows*

and Hallelujah Maurice reveals how the rhetoric of race repeatedly embodies film technology endowing it with a powerful mix of authenticity and magic In this way the racialized subject became the perfect medium for showing off shoring up and reintroducing the cinematic apparatus at various points in the history of American film Moving beyond analyzing race in purely thematic or ideological terms Maurice traces how it shaped the formal and technological means of the cinema
