The Cold War did not culminate in World War III as so many in the 1950s and 1960s feared yet it spawned a host of military engagements that affected millions of lives This book is the first comprehensive multinational overview of military affairs during the early Cold War beginning with conflicts during World War II in Warsaw Athens and Saigon and ending with the Cuban Missile Crisis A major theme of this account is the relationship between government policy and military preparedness and strategy Author Jonathan M House tells of generals engaging in policy confrontations with their governments political leaders among them Anthony Eden Nikita Khrushchev and John F Kennedy many of whom made military decisions that hamstrung their own political goals In the pressure cooker atmosphere of atomic preparedness politicians as well as soldiers seemed instinctively to prefer military solutions to political problems And national security policies had military implications that took on a life of their own The invasion of South Korea convinced European policy makers that effective deterrence and containment required building up and maintaining credible forces Desire to strengthen the North Atlantic alliance militarily accelerated the rearmament of West Germany and the drive for its sovereignty In addition to examining the major confrontations nuclear and conventional between Washington Moscow and Beijing including the crises over Berlin and Formosa House traces often overlooked military operations against the insurgencies of the era such as French efforts in Indochina and Algeria and British struggles in Malaya Kenya Cyprus and Aden Now more than fifty years after the events House describes understanding the origins and trajectory of the Cold War is as important as ever By the late 1950s the United States had sent forces to Vietnam and the Middle East setting the stage for future conflicts in both regions House s account of the complex relationship between diplomacy and military action directly relates to the insurgencies counterinsurgencies and confrontations that now occupy our attention across the globe

The British Pacific Fleet Experience and Legacy, 1944-50
 Jon Robb-Webb, 2016-03-16 The British Pacific Fleet was formed in October 1944 and dispatched to fight alongside the USN in the Central Pacific under Admiral Nimitz. Deploying previously unpublished documents, this book reveals how relations between the UK and US forces developed from a starting point of barely repressed suspicion to one where both navies came to understand each other and eventually find a remarkable bond. Born out of a shared experience of Kamikaze attacks, extended operations against bitterly hostile shores, the pooling of knowledge and experience, the two navies underpinned the diplomatic moves in both Washington and London. The book carries the legacy of this experience through to the next Anglo American participation in war, Korea. It illustrates and explains how and why certain lessons were incorporated into the composition, behaviour and structure of the post war Navy. In so doing, the study illustrates how the experience of a few long months at the end of the war in the Pacific would cast a long shadow over these issues in the very different circumstances of the post war world.

How did the West come to be used as a collective self designation signaling political and cultural commonality? When did Westerners begin to refer to themselves in this way? Was the idea handed down from the ancient Greeks or coined by

nineteenth century imperialists Neither writes Georgios Varouxakis in *The West* his ambitious and fascinating genealogy of the idea The West was not used by Plato Cicero Locke Mill or other canonized figures of what we today call the Western tradition It was not first wielded by empire builders It gradually emerged as of the 1820s and was then Varouxakis shows decisively promoted in the 1840s by the French philosopher Auguste Comte whose political project incidentally was passionately anti imperialist The need for the use of the term the West emerged to avoid the confusing or unwanted consequences of the use of Europe The two overlapped but were not identical with the West used to differentiate from certain others within Europe as well as to include the Americas After examining the origins Varouxakis traces the many and often astonishingly surprising changes in the ways in which the West has been understood and the different intentions and consequences related to a series of these contested definitions While other theories of the West consider only particular aspects of the concept and its history if only in order to take aim at its reputation Varouxakis s analysis offers a comprehensive account that reaches to the present day exploring the multiplicity of current and not least prospective future meanings He concludes with an examination of how since 2022 definitions and membership of the West have been reworked to consider Ukraine as the evolution and redefinitions continue Searching for Place Lubomyr Y. or Democratic Congresses How can the vast array of issues and personalities that have surfaced in American politics over the last forty years fit so neatly within indeed reinforce the sustaining political pattern of our time These big questions constitute the puzzle of modern American politics The old answer a majority and a minority party plus dominant and recessive public issues will not work in the Era of Divided Government Byron Shafer a political scientist who is regarded as one of the most comprehensive and original thinkers on American politics provides a convincing new answer that has three major elements These elements in combination not divided government as a catch phrase are the real story of politics in our time The first element is comprised of two great sets of public preferences that manifest themselves at the ballot box as two majorities The old cluster of economic and welfare issues has not so much been displaced as simply joined by a second cluster of cultural and national concerns The second element can be seen in the behavior of political parties and party activists whose own preferences don't match those of the general public That public remains reliably left of the active Republican Party on economic and welfare issues and reliably right of the active Democratic Party on cultural and national concerns The third crucial element is found in an institutional arrangement the distinctively American matrix of governmental institutions which converts those first two elements into a framework for policymaking year in and year out In the first half of the book Shafer examines how dominant features of the Reagan first Bush Clinton and second Bush administrations reflect the interplay of these three elements Recent policy conflicts and institutional combatants in Shafer's analysis illuminate this new pattern of American politics In the second half he ranges across time and nations to put these modern elements and their composite pattern into a much larger historical and institutional framework In this light modern American politics appears not so much as new and different but as a distinctive recombination of familiar elements of a political style a political process and a political conflict that has been running for a much much longer time
