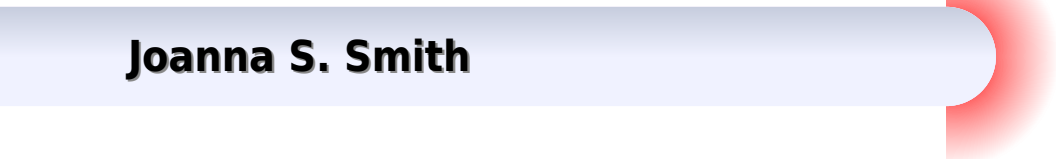

Contemporary Art from Cyprus Elena Stylianou, Evanthia Tselika, Gabriel Koureas, 2020 This edited volume uses Cyprus as a case study for the exploration of notions of the global and the local identity and regionalism in contemporary art practices This book is not a complete historiography of contemporary Cypriot art rather this critical text provides a theoretical and historical framework that both contextualizes and frames current and future art practices from Cyprus and always relates these back to the international art scene Numerous current and pressing issues all relevant beyond Cyprus are investigated in this volume these include but are not limited to art as capital the emergence of the periphery the importance of thriving localities issues on memory and memorialization archaeology artists identities conflict and politics social engagement gender politics and curatorial alternatives artist run spaces **Ancient Cyprus** Stanley Casson, 1977 The Art of Cyprus Liudmila Akimova, 2024 In Russia interest in the art of ancient Cyprus dates back to the first half of the 19th century but since then only a few special works have been published The present book includes eight articles on Cypriot art ranging from Neolithic to the Late Classical periods For the first time they fully present to the reader some outstanding monuments from Russian collections such as the Hermitage oinochoe with a goddess and a hunter the Moscow tombstone with a banquet scene or long forgotten items like Cypriot seals from the Golenischev collection They also give new interpretations to famous Cypriot objects such as the Vounous model or Marion jugs with plastic figurines and raise new questions about old topics connections between Early Bronze Age and Trypolite Cucuteni pottery the plot of ritual meal Despite the difference in approaches all authors are united by the desire to better understand the essence and spirit of Cypriot art and its deep originality in relation to the Oriental and Greek **Ancient Art from Cyprus** Metropolitan Museum of Art (New York, N.Y.), Vassos Karageorghis, Joan R. Rose, 2000 The Cesnola Collection in The Metropolitan Museum of Art is the richest and most varied representation outside Cyprus of Cypriot antiquities These works were purchased by the newly established Museum in the mid 1870s from General Luigi Palma di Cesnola a Civil War cavalry officer who had amassed the objects while serving as the
