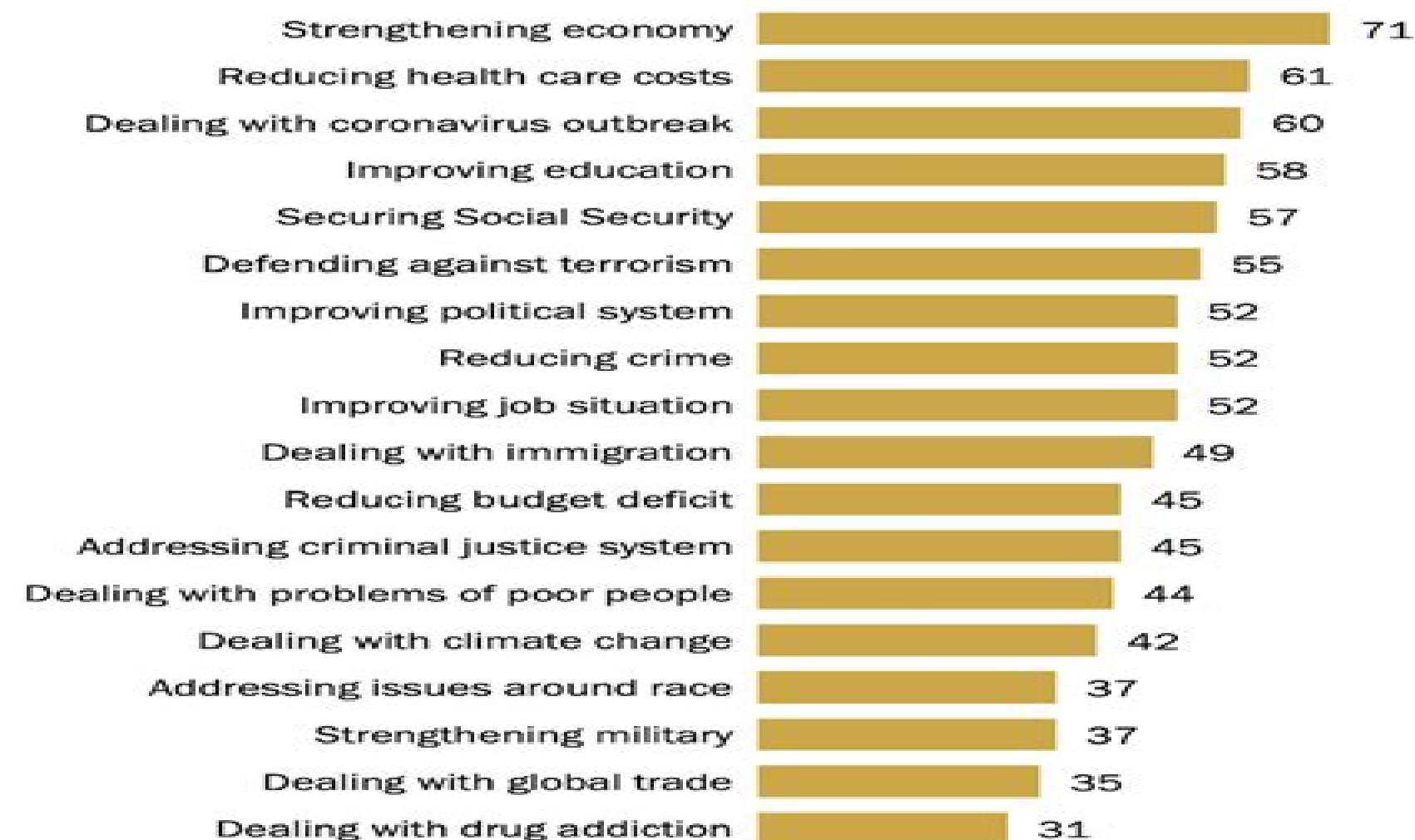


Strengthening the economy is public's top concern, followed by cutting health costs, addressing COVID-19
