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## AMERICAN POPULATION BEFORE THE FEDERAL CENSUS OF 1790

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The first Federal Census in America was taken in 1790. But in estimating the population before that date, the official reports of governors, militia lists, tax lists, genealogies, church records, private records, and records of shipping companies, give the basis for valuable compilations of total population, geographical distribution, distribution by age, sex, race, servile or free state, and in some instances religious affiliations.

Hitherto there have been two compilations of major importance to students of American history: The first was made by the late Franklin B. Dexter in his *Estimate of Population in the American Colonies*, contributed to the American Antiquarian Society in 1887, and the compilation of the United States Bureau of the Census (1905) entitled *A Century of Population Growth*, edited by Mr. W. A. Rostker, Chief Clerk of the Census.

But much additional material has since been made available for particular colonies and states. The plan of the present work is to assemble in a single volume: (1) the data contained in the earlier compilations; (2) the new material now scattered through a large number of publications, official and unofficial; (3) some additional data drawn from such manuscript collections as those of the Public Record Office in London, the Library of Congress, the New York Public Library, and the Historical Society of Pennsylvania.

The result is a reference volume that will be essential to all serious students of American history.
