- Study of Gender and Politics
 - Power definitions and importance to study:
 - If one person has power, another person does not
 - Max Weber (1978): Ability to impose one's will on others, even in the face of opposition
 - Stephen Lukes (1974) threefold definition:
 - Prevailing in a conflict over overt political preferences
 - Preventing the preferences of others from reaching the agenda
 - Shaping the preferences of others to match yours
 - Common language terms and definitions:
 - Grouping Language:
 - BIPOC – Acronym for Black, Indigenous, and people of color
 - AAPI – Acronym for Asian/Asian American or Pacific Islander
 - LGBTQ+ – Acronym for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer
 - SOGIESC – Acronym for sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression, and sex characteristics, more commonly used in countries outside the United States
 - Building a common language:
 - Sex at Birth – Biological status typically assigned at birth based on external anatomy
 - Intersex – Umbrella term to describe people with differences in reproductive anatomy, chromosomes, or hormones that fall outside the typical definitions of sex
 - Gender – Social construct of norms, behaviors, and roles that varies between societies over time
 - Gender Identity – One's own internal sense of self and their gender, not outwardly visible to others
 - Gender Expression – How a person presents gender outwardly, through name, behavior, clothing, voice, or other perceived characteristics
 - Language for understanding
 - Cisgender (cis) – Adjective describing a person whose gender identity aligns with the sex they were assigned at birth
 - Transgender (trans) – Adjective describing a person whose gender identity differs from the sex assigned at birth
