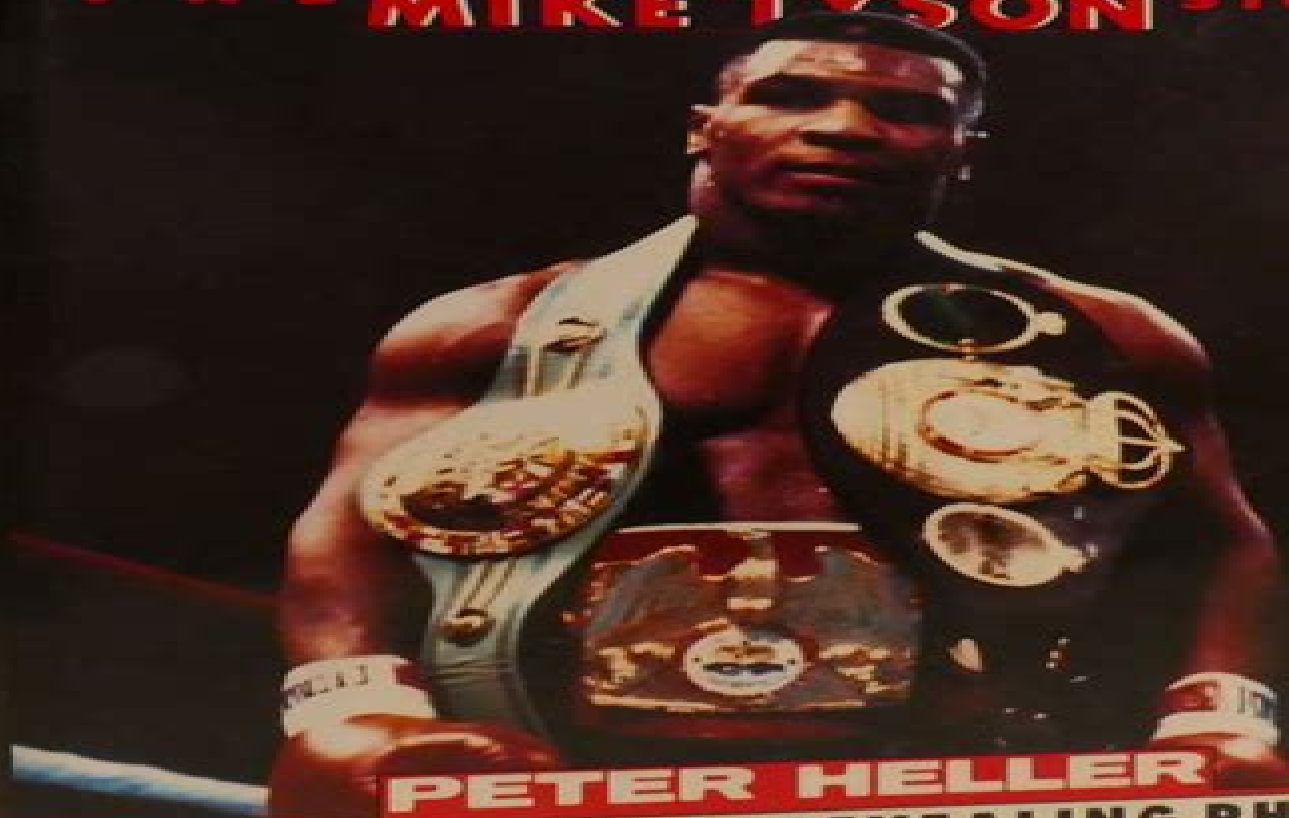

By 1985, finding no other challenging amateur competition, he was forced to join the professional ranks, where in November 1986 he became the youngest heavyweight champion in boxing history. Less than two years later, he unified the crown, establishing himself as one of the most dominant heavyweight fighters the sport had ever seen.

Hell's Kitchen in what some claimed was a gangland execution Peter Benson's biography beautifully captures Battling Siki's amazing boxing career and sheds new light on the scandal surrounding his marriages and public behavior his alleged participation in ring fixes and the mystery surrounding his death
