Cummings,2009-11-15 When the Zoot Suit Riots ignited in Los Angeles in 1943 they quickly became headline news across the country At their center was a series of attacks by U S Marines and sailors on young Mexican American men who dressed in distinctive suits and called themselves pachucos The media of the day portrayed these youths as miscreants and hoodlums Even though the outspoken First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt quickly labeled them victims of race riots the initial portrayal has distorted images ever since A surprising amount of scholarship has reinforced those images writes Laura Cummings proceeding from what she calls the deviance school of thought This innovative study examines the pachuco phenomenon in a new way Exploring its growth in Tucson Arizona the book combines ethnography history and sociolinguistics to contextualize the early years of the phenomenon its diverse cultural roots and its language development in Tucson Unlike other studies it features first person research with men and women who despite a wide span of ages self identify as pachucos and pachucas Through these interviews and her archival research the author finds that pachuco culture has deep roots in Tucson and the Southwest And she discovers the importance of the pachuco cal language variety to a shared sense of pachuquismo Further she identifies previously neglected pachuco ties to indigenous Indian languages and cultures in Mexico and the United States Cummings stresses that the great majority of people conversant with the culture and language do not subscribe to the

dynamics of contemporary hardcore gangs but while zoot suits are no longer the rage today the pachuco language and sensibilities do live on in Mexican American communities across the Southwest and throughout the United States

Amphibians, Reptiles, and Their Habitats at Sabino Canyon David Wentworth Lazaroff, Philip C. Rosen, Charles H. Lowe, 2025-06-10 Even in paradise one needs to be mindful of what's underfoot The Sabino Canyon Recreation Area is a desert oasis in the Santa Catalina Mountains north of Tucson a rich repository of wildlife and a favorite destination for Tucsonans and visitors for more than a century This book presents annotated and illustrated descriptions of the amphibians and reptiles found at Sabino Canyon and an overview of their natural environment Representing a study spanning nearly twenty five years it documents their present and past distribution and examines environmental and herpetofaunal change due to physical biological and human impact on species and habitats In this first publication to describe Sabino Canyon's biota in scientific detail three expert authors pool their knowledge to provide a detailed discussion of ecological change especially as a consequence of drought flooding the introduction of exotic species and direct human impact Suburbia has arrived on the canyon's doorstep and human visitation has soared inalterably affecting the area Of particular concern breeding habitats for amphibians were profoundly altered by flash flooding in Sabino's streams following the 2003 Aspen Fire which ravaged large parts of the Santa Catalina Mountains The book contains richly detailed accounts of the 57 species found at Sabino 25 snakes 17 lizards 8 toads and frogs 6 turtles and 1 salamander emphasizing their local ecology and the behavior likely to be witnessed by visitors Physical descriptions and numerous photographs many in color facilitate identification Up to date distribution maps provide an essential baseline against which future researchers can measure change *Amphibians Reptiles and Their Habitats at Sabino Canyon* is essential for anyone who seeks to understand this desert oasis how it has changed and how it may change in the future Written with minimal technical jargon to make it as useful to students and visitors as it will be to scientists and resource managers it makes a vital contribution to our understanding of creatures underfoot whose habitat we seek to share

The Great Cacti David Yetman, 2007 Towering over deserts arid scrublands and dry tropical forests giant cacti grow throughout the Americas from the United States to Argentina often in rough terrain and on barren parched soils places inhospitable to people But as David Yetman shows many of these tall plants have contributed significantly to human survival Yetman has been fascinated by columnar cacti for most of his life and now brings years of study and reflection to a wide ranging and handsomely illustrated book Drawing on his close association with the Guarij os Mayos and Seris of Mexico peoples for whom such cacti have been indispensable to survival he offers surprising evidence of the importance of these plants in human cultures *The Great Cacti* reviews the more than one hundred species of columnar cacti with detailed discussions of some 75 that have been the most beneficial to humans or are most spectacular Focusing particularly on northwestern Mexico and the southwestern United States Yetman examines the role of each species in human society describing how cacti have provided food shelter medicine even religiously significant hallucinogens Taking

readers to the exotic sites where these cacti are found from sea level deserts to frigid Andean heights Yetman shows that the great cacti have facilitated the development of native culture in hostile environments yielding their products with no tending necessary Enhanced by over 300 superb color photos The Great Cacti is both a personal and scientific overview of sahuessos soberbios and other towering flora that flourish where few other plants grow and that foster human life in otherwise impossible places

Borderman Federico Jose Maria Ronstadt, Edward F. Ronstadt, 2003-04-01 Born in Sonora in 1868 to a Mexican mother and a German father Federico Ronstadt was the quintessential borderman He came to Arizona Territory as a young man to learn a trade and eventually became an American

citizen but with many relatives on both sides of the border Federico was equally at home in Mexico and in his adopted country Writing proudly of his Mexican and American heritages Ronstadt offers readers an extraordinary portrait of the Arizona Mexico borderlands during the late nineteenth century His memoirs provide a richness of detail and insight unmatched by traditional histories relating such scenarios as the hardships of Yaqui hardrock miners working under primitive conditions the travails of pearl divers in the Gulf of California and the insurrection of Francisco Serna in 1875 Sonora They also depict the simple activities of childhood with its schooling and musical training its games and mischief Ronstadt relates his apprenticeship to a wagon and carriage maker in Tucson recalling labor relations in the shop the establishment of his own business and the joys and anguish of his personal life He tells of how he drew on talents nurtured in childhood to become a musician and bandleader playing weekly concerts with Club Filarm nica Tucsonense for nine years musical talents that were eventually passed on to his children his grandchildren including Linda and great grandchildren Through Ronstadt s memories we are better able to understand the sense of independence and self reliance found today among many lifelong residents of Sonora and Baja California people isolated from major supply sources and centers of power and to appreciate a different view of Tucson s past Enhanced by 22 historical photos Borderman is a treasure trove of historical source material that will enlighten all readers interested in borderlands history

The Ópatas David Yetman, 2010-11-15 In 1600 they were the largest most technologically advanced indigenous group in northwest Mexico but today though their descendants presumably live on in Sonora almost no one claims descent from the patas The patas seem to have disappeared as an ethnic group their languages forgotten except for the names of the towns plants and geography of the Opater a where they lived Why did the patas disappear from the

he is affectionately known by many offers nothing less than the living traditions of Catholic communities Themes of saints as agents of protection or community action are common throughout Sonora a saint coming out of the church to protect the village a statue having a say in where it resides and paying social calls to other communities or a beloved image rescued from destruction and then revered on a private altar A patron saint saves a village from outside attackers in one story a story that has at least ten parallels in Sonora s former mission communities Details may vary but the general narrative remains the same when hostile nonbelievers attack the village the patron saint of the church foils them Griffith uncovers the meanings behind the devotional uses of religious art from a variety of perspectives from artist to audience preservationist to community member The religious artworks transcend art objects Griffith believes and function as ways of communicating between this world and the next Setting the stage with a brief geography Griffith introduces us to roadside shrines artists fiestas saints and miracles Full color images add to the pleasure of this delightful journey through the churches and towns of Sonora
