Basic Questions of Philosophy Martin Heidegger, 1994-06-22 This excellent translation presents Heidegger's mature thought on the essence of Truth as he was writing his major work *Contributions to Philosophy* Library Journal This is the first English translation of a lecture course Martin Heidegger presented at the University of Freiburg in 1937-1938 Heidegger's task here is to reassert the question of the essence of truth not as a problem or as a matter of logic but precisely as a genuine philosophical question in fact the one basic question of philosophy Thus this course is about the essence of truth as well as the essence of philosophy itself On both sides Heidegger draws extensively upon the ancient Greeks on their understanding of truth as *aletheia* and their determination of the beginning of philosophy as the disposition of wonder In addition these lectures were presented at the time that Heidegger was composing his second magnum opus *Beiträge zur Philosophie* and provide the single best introduction to that complex and crucial text

The Artist-Philosopher in the Age of Addiction

George Smith, 2025-03-17 George Smith argues that modern humanity suffers from a late stage pre fatal addiction to scientific technological thinking Like most pre fatal addictions this one will most likely result in one of three ways misery extinction or human transformation The question remains wherein lies the third way According to Smith mankind's chronic and as yet undiagnosed sickness originates in early Western metaphysics and has long been thoroughly globalized It explains unstoppable extractionism and its relentlessly increasing by product carbon dioxide It also explains today's ever increasing rate of species extinction and the increasingly likely collapse of the biosphere Citing climate change tolerance and denial as symptomatic of pre fatal addiction Smith turns his analysis to Heidegger's question concerning technology and shows that even Heidegger had become hooked on scientific technological thinking Surrendering to his disease Heidegger steps back into meditative thought This in turn opens Heidegger to an East West mode of scientific poetic consciousness the thinking of artist philosophers such as Laozi Hölderlin and Rachel Carson For Heidegger this way of thinking lays the path to mankind's transformative emancipation from an otherwise inescapable catastrophe The book will be of interest to scholars of the arts and culture histories of consciousness and climate studies

Lee Braver, 2015-11-25 Heidegger's *Being and Time* is one of the most influential and important books in the history of philosophy but it was left unfinished The parts we have of it Divisions I and II of Part One were meant to be merely preparatory for the unwritten Division III which was to have formed the point of the entire book when it turned to the topic of being itself In this book leading Heidegger scholars and philosophers influenced by Heidegger take up the unanswered questions in Heidegger's masterpiece speculating on what Division III would have said and why Heidegger never published it The contributors task to produce a secondary literature on a nonexistent primary work seems one out of fiction by Borges or Umberto Eco Why did Heidegger never complete *Being and Time* Did he become dissatisfied with it Did he judge it too subjectivistic not historical enough too individualistic too existential Was abandoning it part of Heidegger's *Kehre* his
