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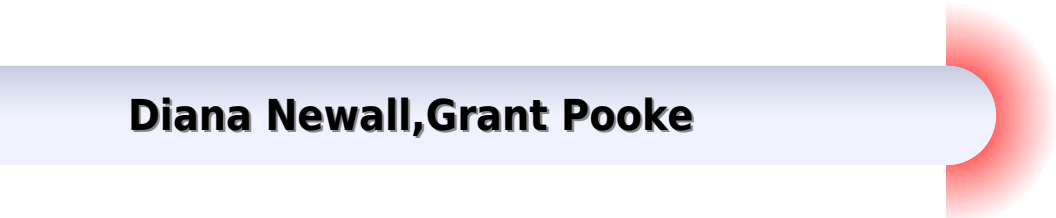

He proposes that in ancient Israel, texts evoked images as a core part of their rhetoric. Rather than conceptualizing texts and images as ontologically or functionally distinct media, he argues that both media are mixed media, even while neither medium is reducible to the other. In order to make this argument, he focuses on the visual aspects of textual rhetoric, what he terms the poetics of visuality. He builds his argument across three text-specific axes of visual rhetoric: ekphrasis, the visual imagination, and material agency. He makes the claim that each of these three axes are endemic to Israelite literature and mutually contribute to the formation of a robust ontology of visual representation in ancient Israel.
