America advocating for a modern approach to the martial arts and showing little regard for the damaged egos left in his wake The year of 1964 would be an eventful one for Bruce in which he would broadcast his dissenting worldview before the first great international martial arts gathering and then defend it by facing down Wong Jack Man Chinatown's young kung fu ace in a legendary behind closed doors showdown These events were a catalyst to the dawn of martial arts in America and a prelude to an icon Based on over one hundred original interviews *Striking Distance* chronicles Bruce Lee's formative days amid the heated martial arts proving ground that thrived on San Francisco Bay in the early 1960s
